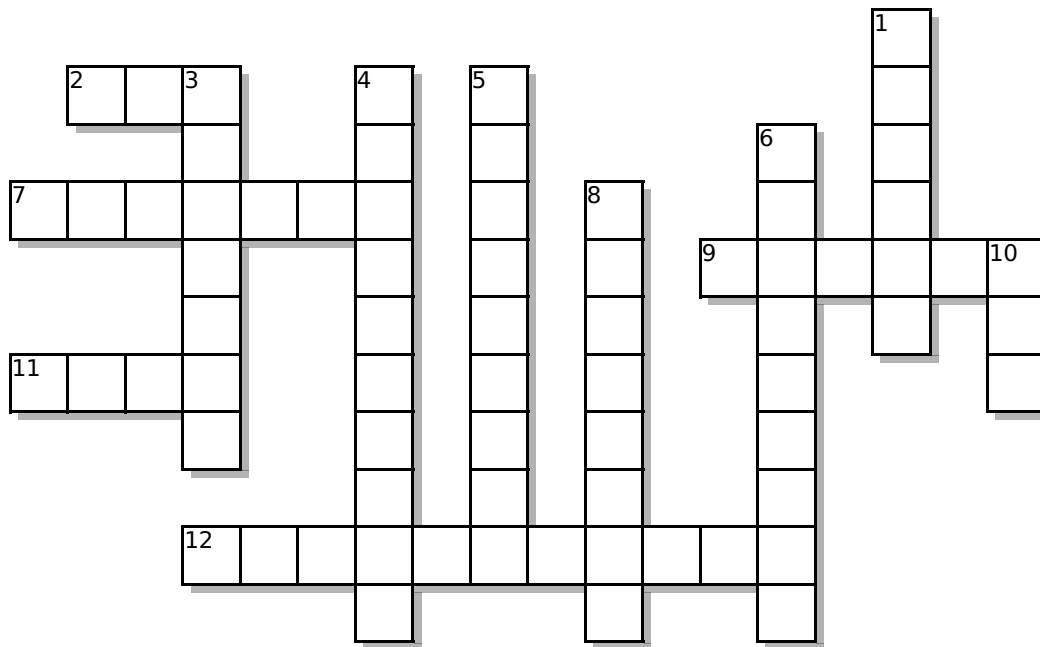


Tudor and Plantagenet Coronations

- 7 Anne Boleyn, second wife of Henry VIII, was crowned on this feast day.
- 9 Anne Boleyn's coronation was different from those of other queen consorts because she was crowned with the crown of this saint.
- 11 Edward IV was crowned on 28th of this month in 1461 at Westminster Abbey.
- 12 Richard III was crowned king on 6th July 1483 in a joint coronation with his wife, who was she?

- 1 At Edward VI's coronation on 20th February 1547, Archbishop Cranmer spoke of Edward being a second
- 3 Mary I was crowned on 1st of this month in 1553.
- 4 Mary I was crowned by the Bishop of this diocese.
- 5 Elizabeth of York was crowned on 25th November 1487, the feast of this saint.
- 6 Henry VIII and Catherine of Aragon were crowned on the feast of St John the Baptist which was also this special day.
- 8 This monarch was crowned on 30th October 1485.
- 10 The surname of the man who drew up an astrological chart to choose an auspicious date for Elizabeth I's coronation.
