- 1 A Dudley who served Henry VII as a chief minister but was executed by Henry VIII in 1510.
- 2 Henry VII's other chief minister who was also executed in 1510.
- 3 William Cecil, Elizabeth I's chief advisor, held this barony.
- 4 The owner of Hampton Court Palace who served Henry VIII until his fall in 1529.
- 5 This chief minister to Henry VII built the "Old Palace" of Hatfield House.
- 6 This Tudor statesman was executed on 28th July 1540.
- 7 This former Lord Chancellor is the patron saint of statesmen and politicians.
- 8 Elizabeth I's "spymaster" and principal secretary.
- 9 This Secretary of State, Lord Chancellor and Lord High Admiral was 1st Earl of Southampton.
- 10 This brother of a queen was Lord Protector in Edward VI's reign.
- 11 John Dudley was Lord President of the Council and also Duke of this county.
- 12 This Earl of Salisbury served Elizabeth I and James I as Secretary of State.
- 13 Stephen Gardiner served Mary I as Lord Chancellor and also held this bishopric.
- 14 This William was 1st Marquess of Winchester and Lord High Treasurer.
