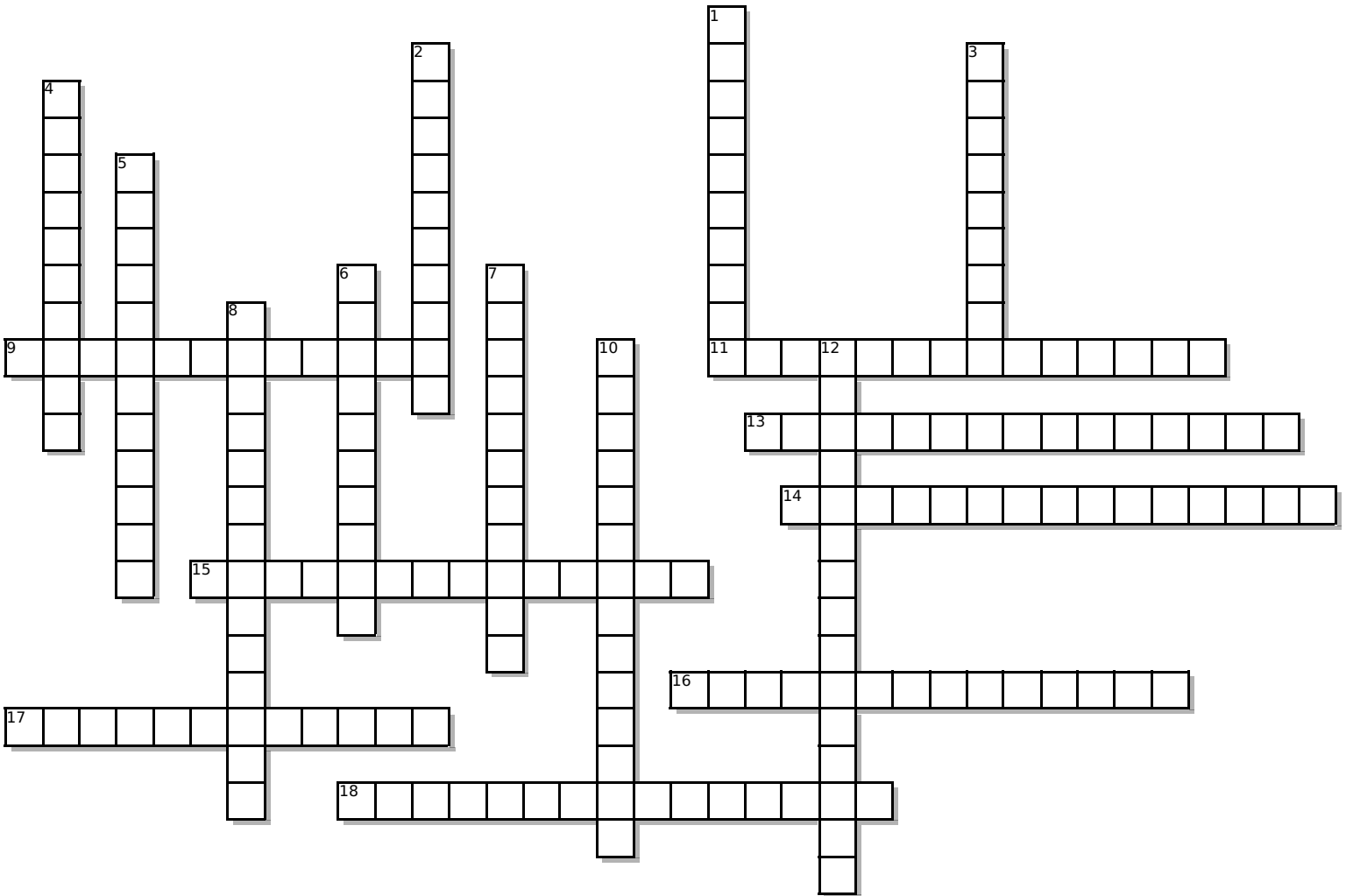


# Tudor February Events



## ACROSS

- 9 Mary, Queen of Scots, was executed at this castle on 8th February 1587.  
 11 This man rebelled against Elizabeth I in February 1601.  
 13 This Tudor man was executed the same day as his wife, Jane, on 12th February 1554.  
 14 This woman was executed with one of her ladies on 13th February 1542.  
 15 This Duke of Buckingham was born on 3rd February 1478 and was executed in 1521.  
 16 Elizabeth Talbot, Countess of Shrewsbury, died on 13th February 1608. What is she commonly known as?  
 17 This poet and courtier nicknamed the "Vicar of Hell" died on 2nd February 1550 in Ireland.  
 18 This uprising took place in February 1554.

## DOWN

- 1 This Protestant Bishop of Gloucester and Worcester was burned at the stake on 9th February 1555.

- 2 This woman married Sir William Carey on 4th February 1520.  
 3 The remains of reformers Martin Bucer and Paul Fagius were exhumed and burned in this town on 6th February 1557.  
 4 This man was born on 7th February 1477/78 and was Henry VIII's Lord Chancellor from 1529 until 1532.  
 5 This Chief Gentlewoman of the Privy Chamber died at the age of 82 on 12th February 1590.  
 6 The name of the first Protestant martyr of Mary I's reign, who was burned at the stake on 4th February 1555.  
 7 This man was murdered at Kirk o' Field, Edinburgh, on 10th February 1567.  
 8 On 1st February 1587, Elizabeth I asked this man to bring her Mary, Queen of Scots' death warrant.  
 10 This physicist, mathematician, astronomer, and philosopher was born on 15th February in Pisa, Italy in 1564 and was one of the central figures of the Scientific Revolution.  
 12 This queen consort's birth and death day was 11th February.
