

- 1 This composer, musician and organ builder died on 12 March 1628.
- 7 28 March 1483 is one of the birthdates given for this Italian Renaissance artist and architect.
- 8 This edict/peace was signed on 19 March 1563 by Catherine de' Medici, as regent for her son, Charles IX.
- 10 In a sermon preached on Easter Sunday 1532, Friar William Peto compared Henry VIII to this Biblical character.
- 11 This religious house was dissolved on 23 March 1540 and was the last to be dissolved by Henry VIII.
- 12 This diplomat and administrator died on 30 March 1587. He'd been Thomas Cromwell's secretary before being noticed by King Henry VIII.
- 13 This astrologer, mathematician, alchemist, antiquary, spy, philosopher, geographer and royal adviser is recorded as dying on 26 March 1609.
- 14 This wife of Charles Brandon and Richard Bertie was born on 22 March 1519.
- 15 This philosoper was born on 31 March 1596 and is

- known for his dictum "I think, therefore I am".
- 16 Rebecca Rolfe was buried in Gravesend, Kent, on 21 March 1617. What was her name before she was baptised in 1614?

- 1 This metaphysical poet, satirist, lawyer and clergyman died on 31 March 1631.
- 2 This woman was pressed to death in York on 25 March 1586 for harbouring Catholic priests.
- 3 This Marquis of Winchester died on 10 March 1572. His offices under Henry VIII included Lord Treasurer, Great Master of the Household and Lord Great Chamberlain.
- 4 The author of "Le Morte d'Arthur" who died on 14 March 1471.
- 5 Elizabeth I died here on 24 March 1603.
- 6 On 10 March 1526, Charles V married of Portugal.
- 9 This treaty between England and Spain was signed on 27 March 1489.
