
## March Tudor Events



## **ACROSS**

- 3 This cardinal and Archbishop of Canterbury died on 3rd March 1500.
- 4 The First Act of ...... was passed on 23rd March 1534.
- 5 This Tudor and Stuart physician, poet and musician wrote the 1595 "Poemata, a collection of Latin panegyrics, elegies and epigrams" and died on 1st March 1620.
- 6 This man was murdered in front of Mary, Queen of Scots, on 9th March 1566.
- 9 This Lord High Admiral was executed for treason on 20th March 1549.
- 11 The queen consort of James VI (and I) who died on 2nd March 1619.
- 12 Sixty-three Huguenot worshippers were killed, and over a hundred injured at this massacre in France on 1st March 1562.
- 13 This was seen and recorded by Paul Fabricius, mathematician and physician at Charles V's court,

on 7th March 1556.

14 Margaret Tudor married Henry Stewart, Lord ......, on 3rd March 1528.

## **DOWN**

- 1 Thomas Cranmer was burned at the stake in this city on 21st March 1556.
- 2 Pope Leo X was proclaimed pope on 11th March 1511 but which famous Italian family was he a member of?
- 3 Birthplace of Mary Tudor, daughter of Henry VII, on 18th March 1496.
- 7 This Earl of Bedford, who died on 14th March 1555, served Henry VIII as Lord High Admiral and Lord Privy Seal and was an executor of his will.
- 8 The explorer and navigator who was issued letters patent by Henry VII on 5th March 1496.
- 10 Princess Elizabeth (future Elizabeth I) wrote this famous letter to her sister, Mary I, on 17th March 1554 when two of Mary's councillors had been sent to take her to the Tower.
