
April Tudor Events

- 6 The surname of this Sir Nicholas who was acquitted of treason on 17th April 1554. The jurors were arrested after his trial and he remained in prison until January 1555.
- 7 This important Tudor died on 2nd April 1502 at Ludlow Castle.
- 9 Margaret Douglas, Countess of Lennox and daughter of Margaret Tudor, was buried here on 3rd April 1578.
- 12 Francis Drake was dubbed a knight on board The Golden Hind in this dock on 4th April 1581.
- 15 This Tudor spymaster and royal adviser died on 6th April 1590.
- 16 This Thomas was made Earl of Essex on 18th April 1540.

1 This rebel was executed on 11th April 1554.

- 2 This Jesuit martyr and saint was hanged, drawn and quartered in York on 17th April 1595.
- 3 This astrologer, astronomer and magician was born on 14th April 1565. He wrote "Astrostereon".
- 4 A cat dressed as a priest was found hanged on the gallows in this part of London on 8th April 1554.
- 5 This man was summoned to Lambeth on 13th April 1534 to swear his allegiance to the Act of Succession.
- 8 This famous conspirator was baptised in York on 16th April 1570.
- 10 The first name of this Stanley who was 5th Earl of Derby and who died suddenly on 16th April 1595. He was a literary patron.
- 11 On 2nd April 1552, 14-year-old Edward VI came down with measles and this illness.
- 13 Cook Richard Roose wasat Smithfield on 5th April 1531 as punishment for poisoning the household of Bishop Fisher.
- 14 Robert Devereux, 2nd Earl of Essex, was sworn in as Lord Lieutenant of on 15th April 1599.
