- 1 This Thomas was made Earl of Essex in 1540.
- 2 Thomas Seymour, brother of Queen Jane Seymour, was baron of this place.
- 3 Birthplace of Cardinal Thomas Wolsey.
- 4 This Thomas was 2nd Baron of Harrowden and a diplomat and poet.
- 5 Two Tudor Thomases bore this surname: one a poet and the other a rebel.
- 6 This Thomas was Earl of Southampton and Lord Chancellor.
- 7 The book published by Sir Thomas More in 1516.
- 8 This Thomas served as a physician to Henry VIII.
- 9 Archbishop Thomas Cranmer was burnt at the stake here.
- 10 Thomas Boleyn was Earl of Ormonde and
- 11 This Thomas served as Solicitor General and Lord Chancellor, and presided over the trial of Mary, Queen of Scots.
- 12 Thomas Audley served Henry VIII in this position from 1533-1544.
- 13 This Thomas was one of the leaders of the Rising of the North in 1569.
- 14 This Thomas was 3rd Duke of Norfolk and presided over the trials of his nephew and niece, George and Anne Boleyn, in 1536.
- 15 This Thomas had secret assignations with Queen Catherine Howard.
- 16 This Thomas was Earl of Sussex and served as Lord Deputy of Ireland from 1556-1558 and Lord Lieutenant of Ireland 1560-1564.
- 17 This Thomas refounded a library in Oxford that is named after him.
- 18 This Thomas was a merchant and financier who found the Royal Exchange in 1565.
