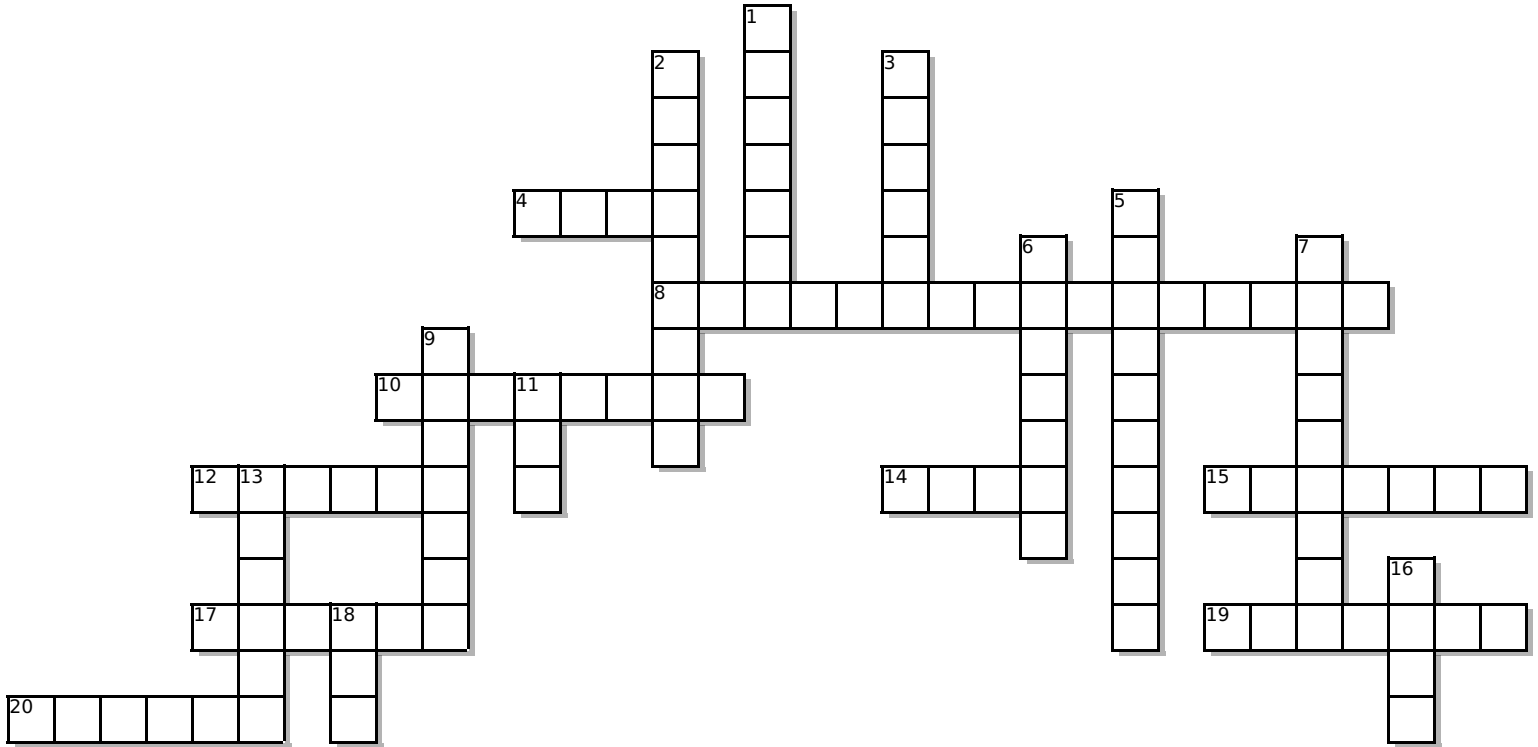


Tudor Edwards Crossword



ACROSS

- 4 This Edward's chronicle is a very useful primary source.
- 8 This Edward was Earl of Lincoln and served Elizabeth I as a privy councillor and Lord Admiral.
- 10 This Edward was the Duke of Buckingham who was executed in 1521.
- 12 This Edward was Elizabeth I's ambassador to the Ottoman Empire and died of dysentery in 1598.
- 14 With Philip Sidney and Fulke Greville, this Edward made up the "happy blessed Trinitie" of poets.
- 15 This Edward was an astrologer, astronomer, mathematician, magician and writer of the treatise "Astrostereon".
- 17 This Edward was an apothecary, alchemist and medium who worked with Sir John Dee.
- 19 This Edward was Lord Protector in his nephew's reign.
- 20 This Edward was 4th Baron Dudley and entertained Elizabeth I at Dudley Castle in 1575.

DOWN

- 1 This Edward was arrested for treason along with his brother-in-law, Henry Pole, in 1558 and executed on 8th December 1558.

- 2 This Edward was guardian to a young John Dudley, Duke of Northumberland, and served as Marshal of Calais, Constable of Dover Castle and Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports.
- 3 This Edward was Earl of Oxford, a courtier and poet, and some believe he even wrote the works attributed to William Shakespeare.
- 5 This Edward was Lieutenant of the Tower of London at Anne Boleyn's fall in 1536.
- 6 This Edward was Baron of Cherbury and author of "The Life and Raigne of King Henry the Eighth".
- 7 This Edward was Earl of Devon, second cousin to Edward VI, Mary I and Elizabeth I, and put forward as a match for both Mary and Elizabeth, the daughter of Henry VIII.
- 9 This Edward was Earl of Derby and served Mary I and Elizabeth I as a privy councillor.
- 11 This Edward was Bishop of Hereford and a diplomat who served Henry VIII in his "Great Matter".
- 13 This Edward was one of the great actors of the Elizabethan period.
- 16 This Edward was the son of Elizabeth Cooke, grandson of Sir Anthony Cooke, and a scholar, theologian, politician and diplomat used by Elizabeth I for secret missions.
- 18 This Edward was Archbishop of York in Henry VIII's reign and also served him as almoner and diplomat.
