
## August Tudor People and Events



## **ACROSS**

- 7 Elizabeth I was godmother at the christening of this courtier, translator and author on 4 August 1560.
- Elizabeth I gave a rousing speech to troops at this fort on 9 August 1588.
- 12 This rebellion took place in the south-west of England in June, July and August of 1549.
- 13 Robert Dudley and this friend of his were appointed as gentlemen of Edward VI's privy chamber on 15 August 1551.
- 15 This apothecary, alchemist and medium was born on 1 August 1555.
- 16 The place where Henry Tudor landed on 7 August 1485 when he returned from exile to claim the English crown.

- Margaret Tudor married this man on 6 August 1514.
- The name of William Shakespeare's wife who died on 6 August 1623.
- The mother of Robert Dudley, Earl of Leicester's

- illegitimate son, also named Robert, who was born on 7
- August 1574.

  Margaret Tudor and James IV married at the chapel of this place on 8 August 1503.
- This former advisor of Henry VII was executed with Edmund Dudley on 17 August 1510.
- This battle took place on 2 August 1595 when Spanish forces landed on English soil.
- This man served Elizabeth I as a Gentleman of the Privy Chamber, was married to her former governess and died on 1 August 1596.
- Edward Stafford, Duke of Buckingham, was granted a
- licence to found a college here in 1514. 10 This Archbishop of Canterbury was born on 6 August 1504 in Norwich.
- 11 This 'battle' between the English and French forces took place on 16 August 1513.
- 14 The first name of the daughter of Margaret Pole who was married to Henry Stafford and who died on 12 August 1570.
- 17 Mary, Queen of Scots, landed at this harbour on 19 August 1561 on her return to Scotland from France.
