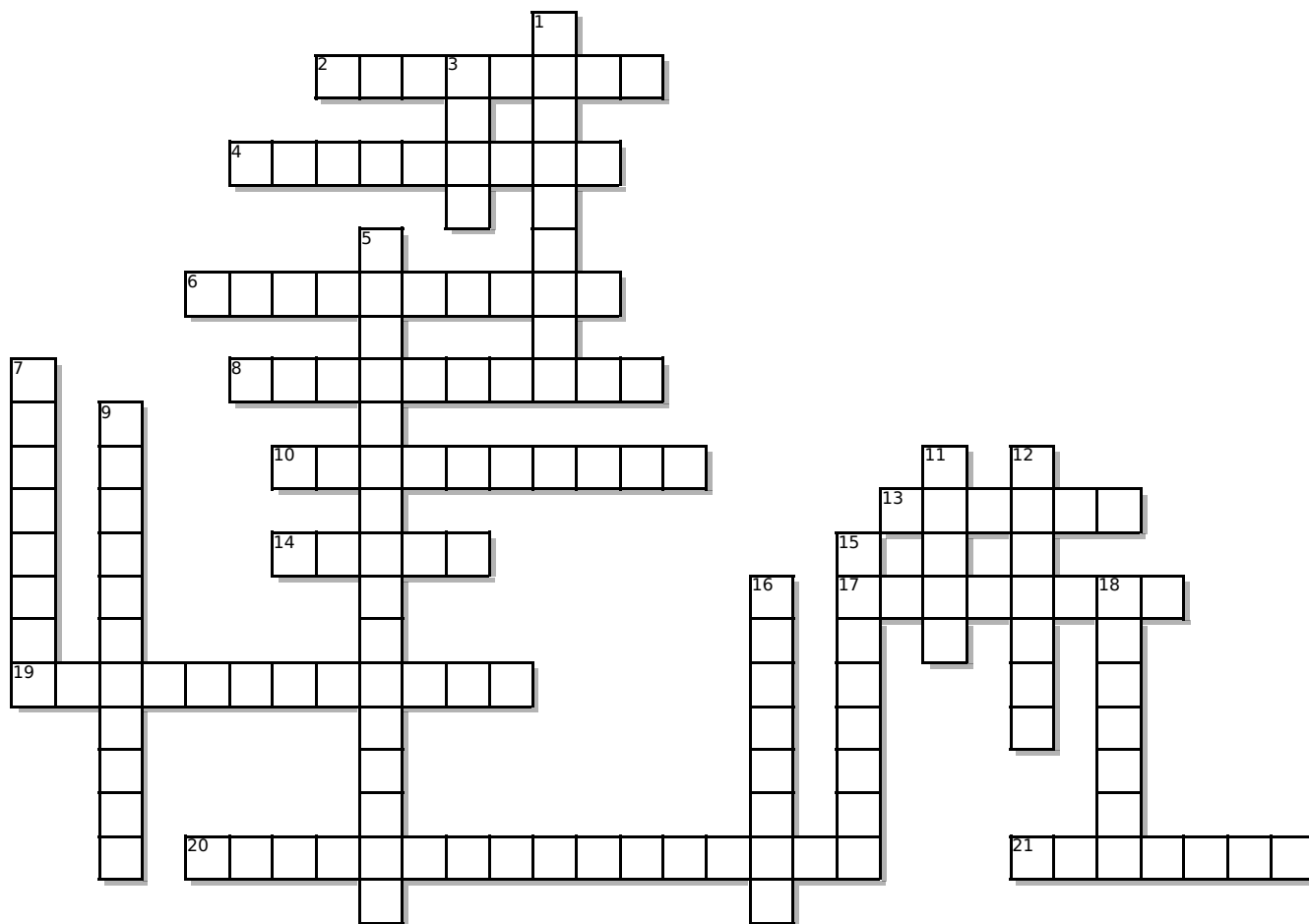


July Tudor Events



ACROSS

- 2 Henry VIII's flagship which sank on 19th July 1545.
- 4 The first name of the son of Katherine (Willoughby or Brandon) and her second husband, Richard Bertie, who was buried at Spilsby on 21st July 1601.
- 6 The name of the battle between the English fleet and the Spanish Armada on 29th July 1588.
- 8 Anne Askew, John Lascelles, John Adams and Nicholas Belenian were executed at this place for heresy on 16th July 1546.
- 10 This architect and theatre designer, who is known for designing Banqueting House, was born on 15th July 1573.
- 13 This cardinal helped Mary of Guise and Mary, Queen of Scots, escape from Linlithgow Palace on 23rd July 1543.
- 14 Joan Cunny, Joan Prentice, Joan Upney and Agnes Waterhouse were all executed for alleged witchcraft in July 1589. They were known as the "..... Witches".
- 17 The palace where Henry VIII married Catherine Howard on 28th July 1540.
- 19 Francis, the Catholic conspirator, was executed at Tyburn on 10th July 1584 for his plot against Elizabeth I.
- 20 This man was executed for treason, with the charges including buggery and having dealings with witches, alongside Thomas Cromwell on 28th July 1540.

- 21 The astrologer, mathematician, alchemist, antiquary, spy, philosopher, geographer and adviser to Elizabeth I who was born on 13th July 1527.

- 1 This former tutor of Edward VI was sent to the Tower on 27th July 1553 for his part in putting Lady Jane Grey on the throne.
- 3 Pilgrimage of Grace rebel, Robert Aske, was hanged in chains at this castle on 12th July 1537.
- 5 The resting place of Anne of Cleves, fourth wife of Henry VIII, who died on 16th July 1557.
- 7 Henry Fitzroy, illegitimate son of Henry VIII, died on 22nd July 1536. He was Duke of Richmond and
- 9 The name of the ships sent amongst the Spanish Armada at Calais which caused an inferno on 28th July 1588.
- 11 This rebellion took place in and around Norwich in July 1549.
- 12 The feast day on which Mary I married Philip of Spain on 25th July 1554.
- 15 Mary, Queen of Scots, married Henry Stuart, Lord Darnley, at this palace on 29th July 1565.
- 16 "A Faithful Admonition to the Professors of God's Truth in England" was published on 20th July 1554, but who was its author?
