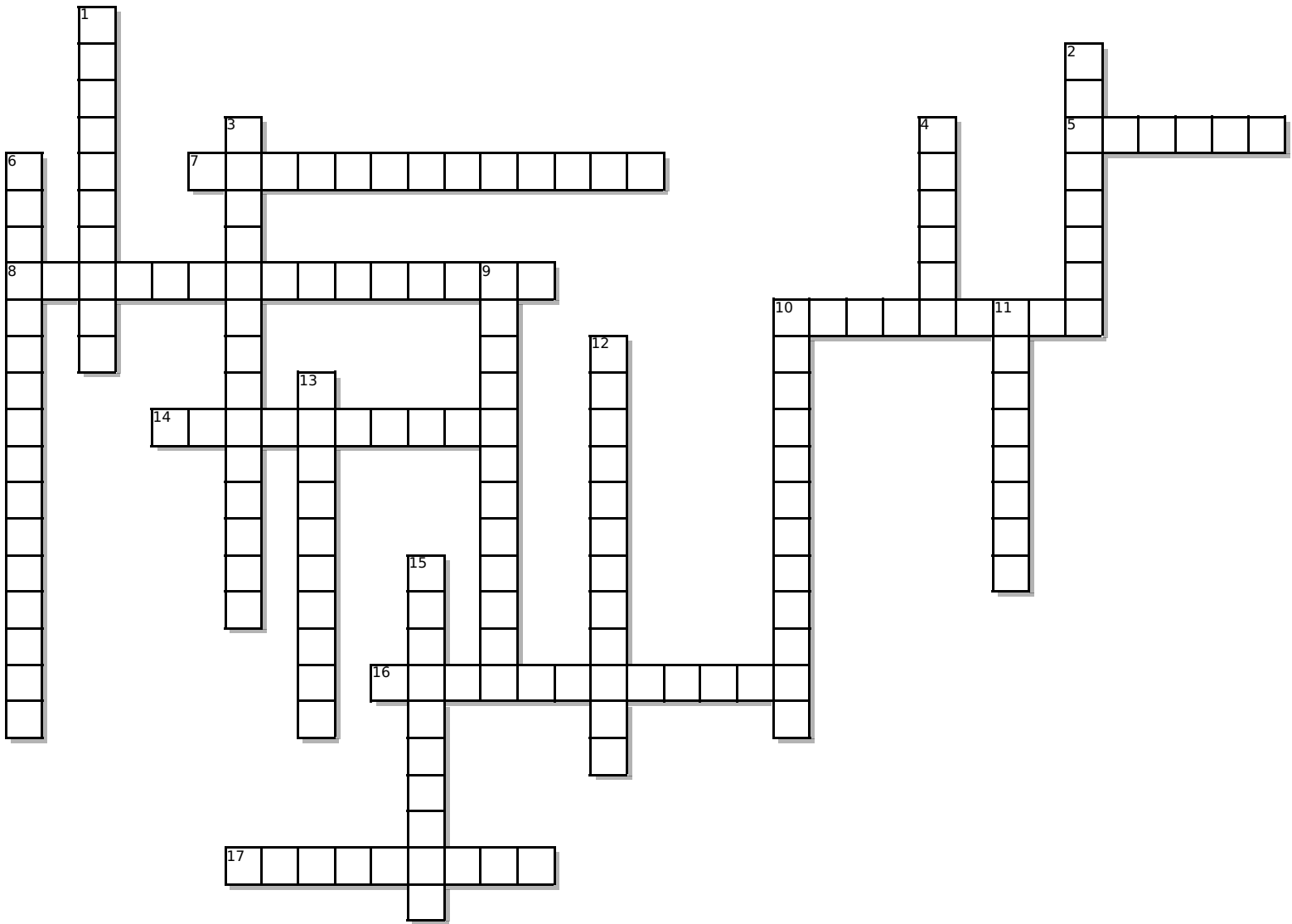


# November Tudor Events



## ACROSS

- 5 This Tudor Thomas was a musician and composer who died on 23rd November 1585.
- 7 This pretender was hanged at Tyburn on 23rd November 1499.
- 8 This person was crowned at Westminster Abbey on 25th November 1487.
- 10 The saint whose feast day was the wedding day of Catherine of Aragon and Arthur Tudor on 14th November 1501, and possibly that of Anne Boleyn and Henry VIII in 1532.
- 14 Edmund Tudor, 1st Earl of Richmond, died from the plague at this castle on 1st November 1456.
- 16 William Shakespeare married this woman at Temple Grafton on 27th November 1582.
- 17 Catherine Howard was moved here from Hampton Court Palace on 14th November 1541.

## DOWN

- 1 Navigator and explorer Sir John Hawkins died here on 12th November 1595.
- 2 Elizabeth was here when she received news of her half-sister Mary I's death and her accession as

Elizabeth I in November 1558.

- 3 Cardinal Thomas Wolsey died here on 29th November 1530.
- 4 Elizabeth I gave this speech to the House of Commons on 30th November 1601. It was the last speech she gave to Parliament.
- 6 This merchant and banker funded a plot against Elizabeth I in 1571 that was uncovered before it could go ahead.
- 9 The name of the archbishop who died on the same day as Mary I (17th November 1558).
- 10 This Elizabethan actor, patron and theatre builder died on 25th November 1626.
- 11 The feast day in 1541 on which Archbishop Cranmer gave Henry VIII a note detailing allegations that had been made against Queen Catherine Howard.
- 12 This royal physician died at Fulham Manor on 22nd November 1545 from malaria.
- 13 Henry Fitzroy, Duke of Richmond and Somerset and the illegitimate son of Henry VIII, married this lady on 26th November 1533.
- 15 This former Lord Deputy of Ireland died at the Tower of London on 3rd November 1592. Some believe him to have been the illegitimate son of Henry VIII.
