- 14 Mince pies don't tend to contain mutton today and it is replaced with this animal product
- 15 A traditional wassail drink made with hot ale and apples
- 16 The French name for the chocolate yule log cake served at Christmas
- 17 This alcoholic drink is poured over Christmas pudding and is also used to flavour sauce and butter for the Christmas pudding
- 18 Christmas incorporates this midwinter festival
- 19 Houses made of this are a popular Christmas tradition
- 20 Christmas pudding is traditionally cooked in this way
- 21 This was invented to help the post office

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
