- 4 Name of the Castle where Catherine of Aragon died on 7th January 1536.
- 5 Surname of the imperial ambassador who visited Catherine of Aragon for a few days before her death in January 1536.
- 6 The pageant to welcome Anne of Cleves on 3rd January 1540 spread from Blackheath to this palace.
- 7 Anne of Cleves visited the king and Catherine Howard on 3rd January 1541. What did she bring as gifts to the king.
- 8 Surname of Sir Thomas More's son-in-law who wrote a biography of More and who died on 4th January 1578.
- 9 Name of the Pope who ordered Henry VIII not to remarry on pain of excommunication on 5th January 1531.
- 10 The feast day on which Henry VIII and Anne of Cleves married in January 1540.
- 11 Henry VIII was recording as dressing in this colour on 8th January 1536 after he'd heard news of his first wife's death.
- 12 The name of the conspiracy which Henry Pole and Henry Courtenay, who were executed on 9th January 1539, were alleged to have been involved in.
- 13 The first recorded ..... was drawn on 11th January 1569 in London.
- 14 Surname of Henry VIII's groom of the stool who was injured while jousting on 12th January 1510.
- 15 Henry Howard, Earl of this county, was found guilty of treason on 13th January 1547 and executed on 19th January 1547.
- 16 Which Biblical prophetess did a pageant in Fleet Street depict Elizabeth I as for her coronation procession on 14th January 1559?
- 17 This queen's astrologer chose the date for Elizabeth I's coronation: 15th January 1559.
