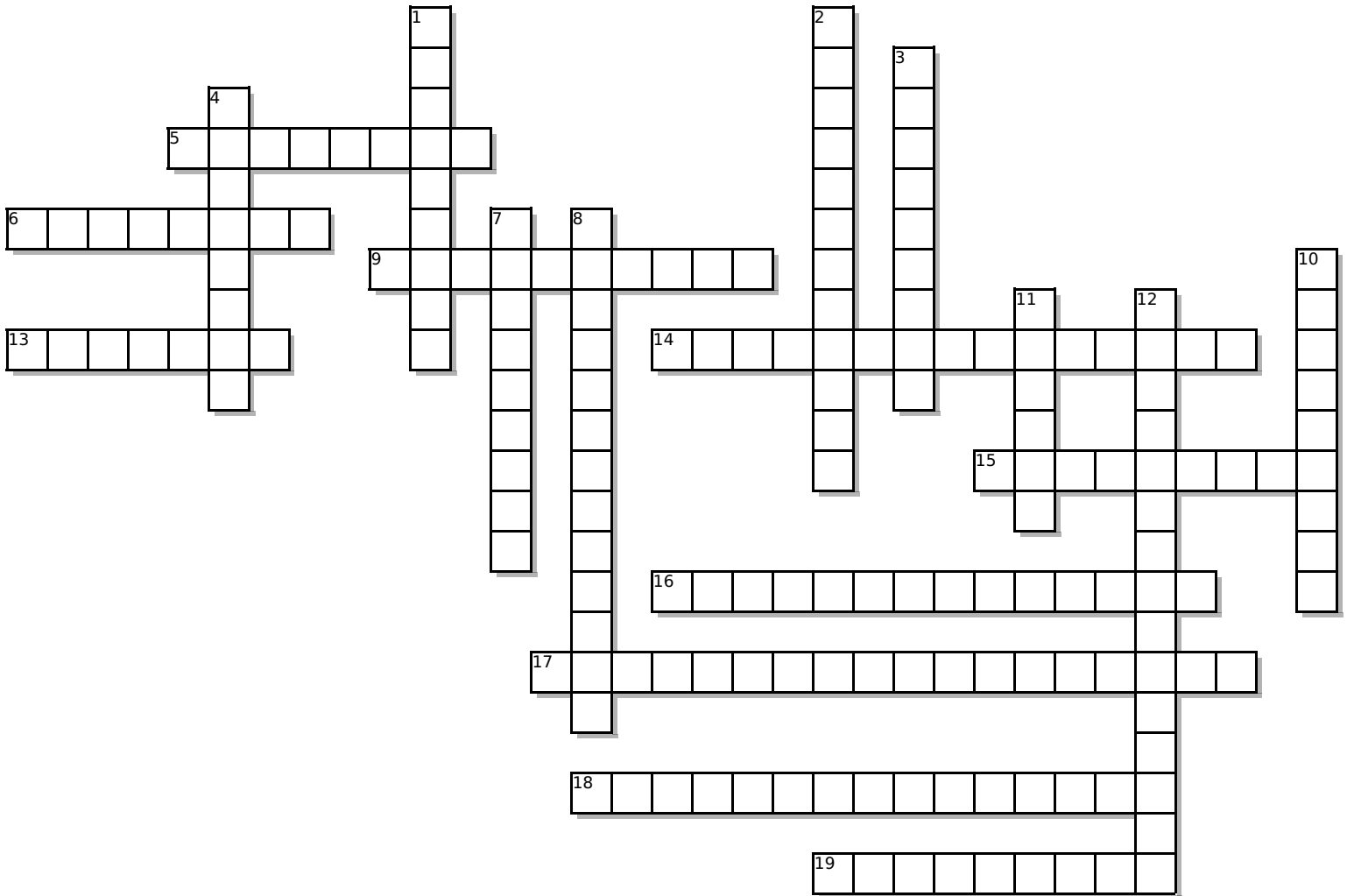


February Tudor Events



ACROSS

- 5 Henry, infant son of Catherine of Aragon and Henry VIII, died on 22 February 1511. What was his dukedom?
- 6 This earl was implicated in the murder of Henry Stuart, Lord Darnley, which took place on 10 February 1567.
- 9 Henry VIII changed the law so that this woman could be executed in February 1542.
- 13 This Tudor Thomas crowned King Edward VI on 20 February 1547.
- 14 This woman died on her birthday on 11 February 1503.
- 15 The English town where the exhumed bodies of reformers Martin Bucer and Paul Fagius were burned on 6 February 1557.
- 16 The name of Elizabeth I's secretary who Elizabeth blamed for not following her instructions regarding Mary, Queen of Scots' death warrant.
- 17 The location of the execution of Mary, Queen of Scots, on 8 February 1587.
- 18 Birthplace of Queen Mary I, who was born there on 18 February 1516.

- 19 The name of the main murderer of businessman Thomas Arden, who was killed on 15 February 1551.

- 1 Mary I gave a rousing speech at this location in London on 1 February 1554.
- 2 Mary Boleyn married this man on 4 February 1520.
- 3 Henry VIII's coffin was said to have leaked while resting at this place on 14 February 1547.
- 4 Edward Seymour was made duke of this county on 17 February 1547.
- 7 Surname of the chaplain who was sent to visit Lady Jane Grey in her final days in an attempt to convert her to Catholicism.
- 8 This person was interred in the sarcophagus that Henry VIII planned to use and Henry was buried in a vault in St George's Chapel, Windsor, on 16 February 1547.
- 10 The feast celebrated on 2 February.
- 11 During his coronation service on 20 February 1547, Edward VI was likened to a second
- 12 This Jesuit priest and poet was executed on 21 February 1595.
