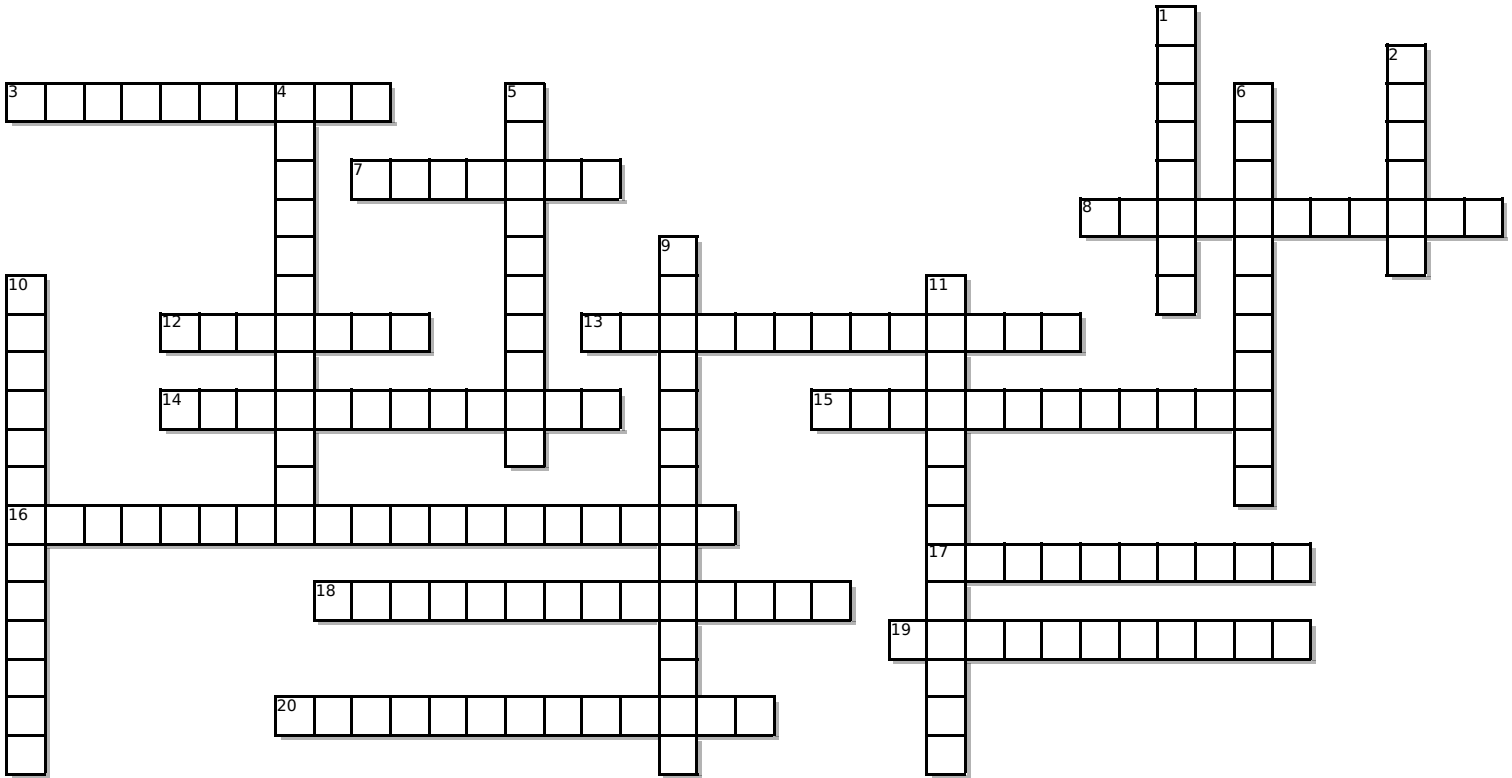


## March "on this day" events
