- 4 The Easter was prepared on Good Friday.
- 5 The fasting period leading up to Easter.
- 6 Jesus entered Jerusalem with this animal.
- 7 Palms were burned and the ashes used on this day the following year.
- 8 This separated the chancel and nave in a church in the lead-up to Easter.
- 9 Whose feet would the monarch traditionally wash on the Thursday of Holy Week.
- 10 This was given out on the Thursday of Holy Week to those in need.
- 11 Christ's was celebrated on Easter Sunday.
- 12 What would Tudor people use to make crosses on Palm Sunday.
- 13 A priest would use this receptacle to carry the host and bless the fields in Holy Week.
- 14 Good Friday commemorates Christ's
- 15 Easter is a, meaning that it does not fall on a fixed date.
- 16 The of Christ is the name for the period of Christ's life between his entry into Jerusalem and his death.
