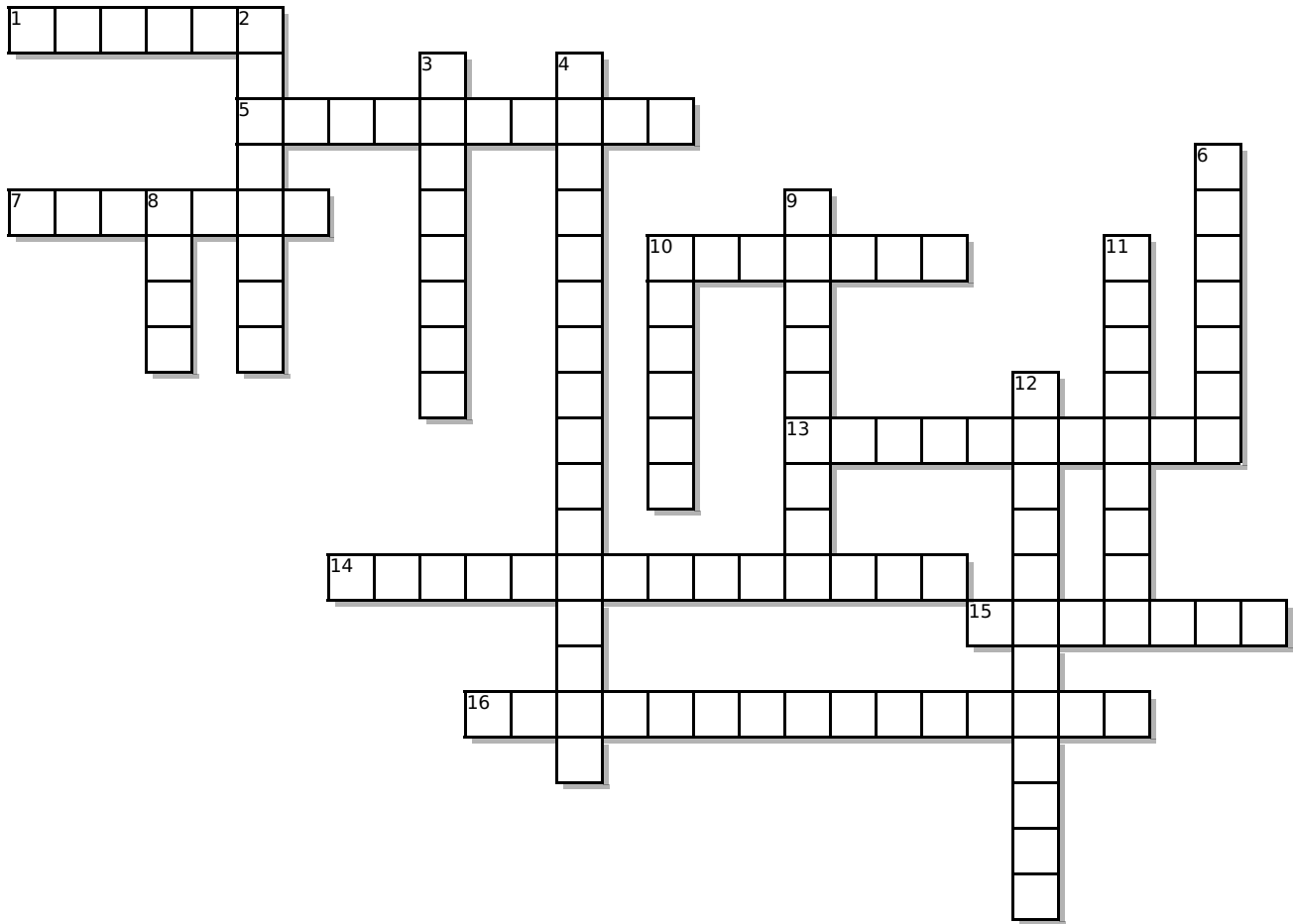


# Horrible Deaths Crossword
