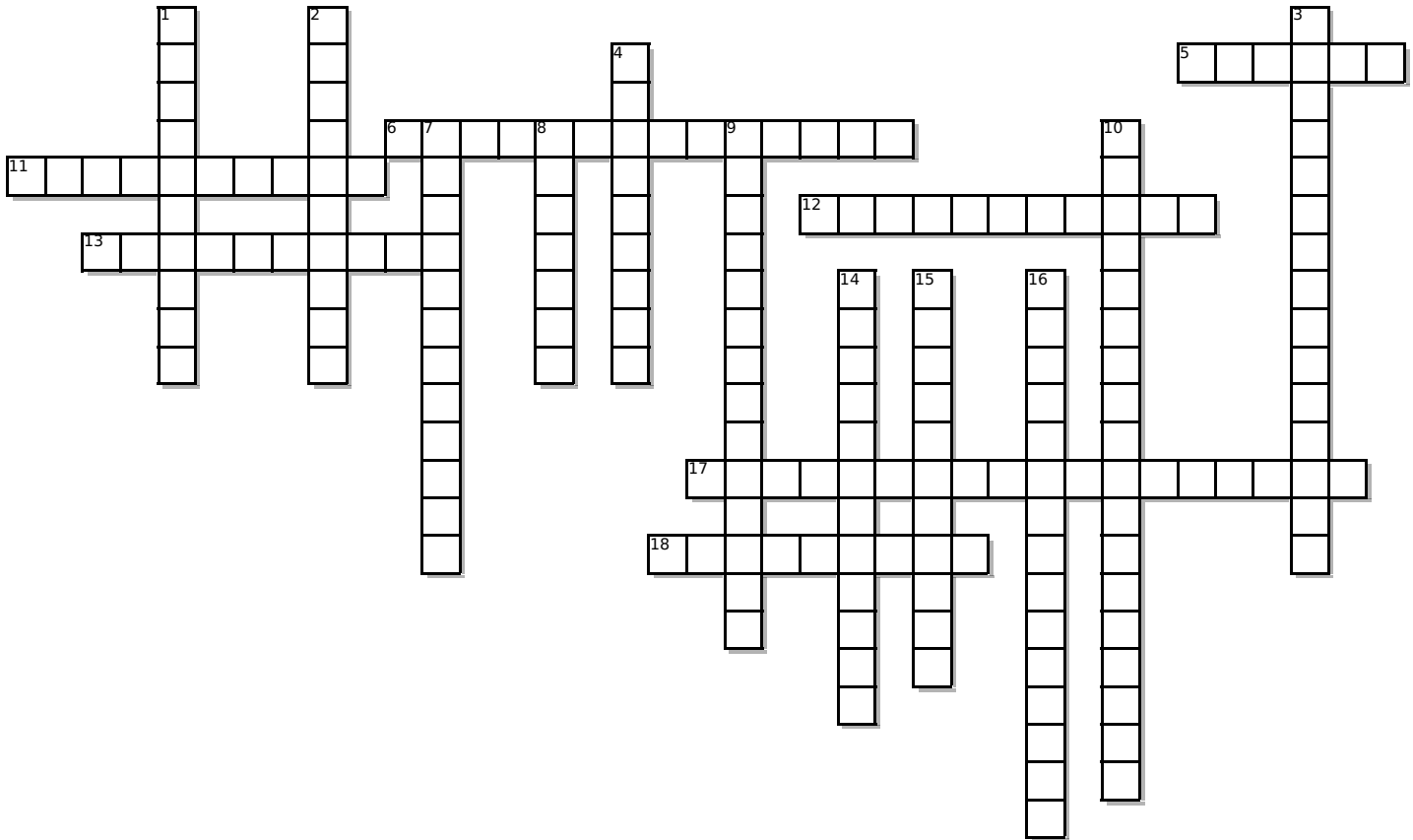


June Tudor Events



ACROSS

- 5 The name of the saint whose crown Anne Boleyn was crowned with on 1st June 1533.
- 6 This Earl of Essex was arrested on 10th June 1540.
- 11 The name of the rebellion which started in the south-west of England in June 1549.
- 12 This man was made cardinal and papal legate on 14th June 1557, but is more famous for preaching a sermon in which he compared Henry VIII to Ahab.
- 13 Richard Sampson was nominated as Bishop of this place by Henry VIII on 3 June 1536.
- 17 The consort of Edward IV who died on 8th June 1492.
- 18 This woman was arraigned for heresy on 18th June 1546. She was later racked, then burned at the stake.

- 1 This battle between Henry VII's forces and those of Lord Lovell and the Earl of Lincoln was fought on 16th June 1487.

- 2 Robert Dudley married this woman on 4th June 1550.
- 3 This woman was sent to the Tower on 20th June 1565 following the betrothal of Mary Queen of Scots and Lord Darnley.
- 4 Mary, Queen of Scots, was imprisoned in this castle on 17th June 1567 after her surrender at the Battle of Carberry Hill.
- 7 This Duke of Richmond and Somerset's birth is traditionally given as 15th June 1519.
- 8 This treaty was signed between Henry VII and Maximilian I on 19th June 1502.
- 9 The good friend of Catherine of Aragon who married William, 10th Lord Willoughby of Eresby, on 5th June 1516.
- 10 The historic meeting which took place between Henry VIII and Francis I in June 1520.
- 14 This court fool died on 15th June 1559.
- 15 The coroner's ruling over the stabbing of Christopher Marlowe by Ingram Frazier at the inquest on 1st June 1593.
- 16 Henry VIII and Catherine of Aragon got married here on 11th June 1509.
