
Tudor Surnames and Families Crossword Puzzle - Part 1

- 6 This baron named Giles served Kings Edward IV and Henry VII, serving Henry as privy councillor, Master of the Mint and Lieutenant of Calais.
- 8 This family held the title of Earl of Sussex in the Tudor period.
- 9 This family held the title Baron Dacre in the 15th and 16th centuries.
- 11 This family gave their name to a 1583 Catholic plot that aimed to depose Queen Elizabeth I.
- 13 This Anthony was a close confidant of King Henry VIII and served him as groom of the stool.
- 14 This Tudor family held the title Baron Berners during the reigns of Henry VII and Henry VIII.
- 15 These Earls of Northumberland owned Alnwick Castle.

16 This family's home was Gidea Hall and the family included a humanist scholar and the wife of Sir William Cecil, Baron Burghley.

DOWN

- 2 John, Earl of Bedford, who served as Lord Privy Seal and Lord High Admiral, was a member of this family.
- 3 The surname of Henry VIII's great friend, the Duke of Suffolk, and the maternal family of Lady Jane Grey.
- 4 This Catholic family owned Hever Castle during the reign of Queen Elizabeth I.
- 5 This William owned the Vyne in Hampshire and served Henry VIII as Lord Chamberlain.
- 7 This family held the dukedom of Buckingham in the 15th and 16th centuries.
- 10 Brothers with this surname famously swapped sides at the Battle of Bosworth in 1485.
- 12 The surname of the family who held the title Baron Cobham in the Tudor period.
