- Elizabeth I's earliest surviving letter, one written to Catherine Parr in July 1554, was written in this language.
- This Tudor Thomas served Henry VIII as Lord Privy Seal and Lord Chancellor, and died on 30 July 1550.
- Agnes Waterhouse, who was hanged on 29 July 1589, was one of the Witches.
- This Walter was executed on 28 July 1540 for charges including buggery.
- This Earl of Essex was executed on the same day that Henry VIII got married for the fifth time (28 July 1540).
- 4,000 men gathered here on 26 July 1588 to defend the Thames and London from the Spanish Armada.
- Mary I and Philip of Spain got married on this feast day (25 July) in 1554.
- Mary, Queen of Scots, was imprisoned at this castle when she was forced to abdicate on 24 July 1567.
- Resting place of Henry Carey, 1st Baron Hunsdon, who died on 23 July 1596.
- Henry Fitzroy, Henry VIII's illegitimate son, died on 22 July 1536. He was Duke of and Somerset.
- This English territory was attacked by the French on 21 July 1545.
- Author of "A Faithful Admonition to the Professors of God's Truth in England", which was published on 20 July 1554.
- The Mary Rose sank during this battle on 19 July 1545.
- The first name of Erasmus, who was buried on 18th July 1536 at Basel Cathedral.
- Name of one of the female Protestant martyr who was burned at the stake on 16 July 1546.
- This architect, who was known for designing Banqueting House, was born on 15 July 1573.
- Henry and Charles Brandon, sons of the late Duke of Suffolk, died from this on 14 July 1551.
- The astrologer, mathematician, alchemist, antiquary, spy, philosopher, geographer and adviser to Elizabeth I who was born on 13 July 1527.
- Henry married his sixth and final wife, Catherine Parr, Lady, on 12 July 1543.
