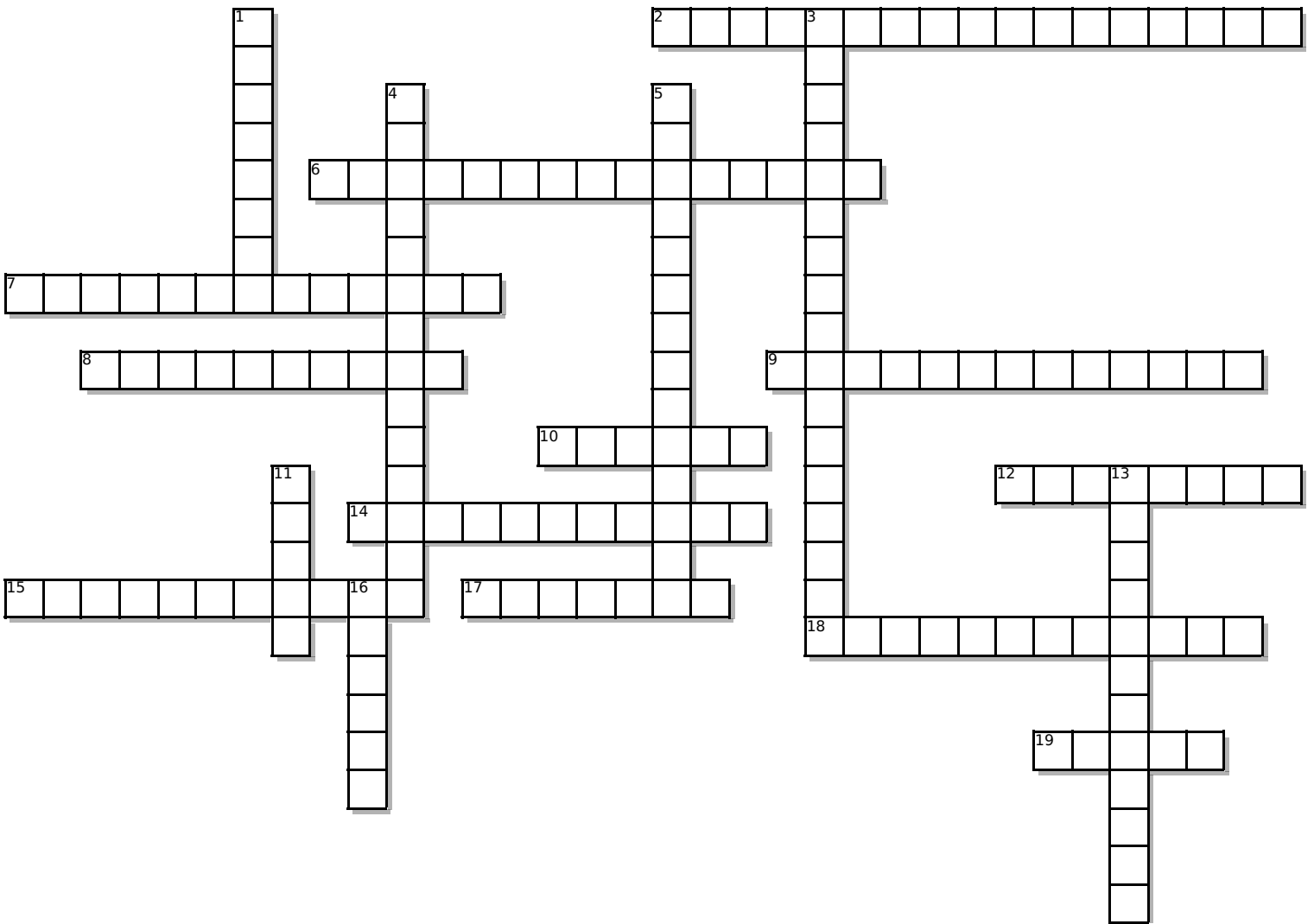


Margaret Tudor Crossword Puzzle



ACROSS

- 2 Margaret was born here on 28th November 1489.
- 6 Margaret gave birth to her daughter, Margaret Douglas, here in 1515.
- 7 Margaret died here on 18th October 1541.
- 8 She was buried at St John's, an abbey of this order, in Perth.
- 9 Margaret and James IV of Scotland married here in person on 8th August 1503.
- 10 Margaret fled to England after this duke replaced her as regent and took custody of her sons.
- 12 This earl stood as proxy for James IV of Scotland at the couple's proxy marriage in January 1503.
- 14 The woman Margaret's husband was living with when Margaret returned to Scotland in 1517.
- 15 Margaret's son, James V, married this woman as his second wife in 1538.
- 17 James IV was killed at this battle.
- 18 Henry VIII organised lodgings here, in Whitehall,

- for Margaret on her arrival in London.
- 19 Margaret spent her early years here, before moving to Eltham Palace.

DOWN

- 1 Henry Stewart, Lord Darnley, who married Margaret's granddaughter, Mary, Queen of Scots, was also related to Margaret - how?
- 3 Margaret's son, James V, married this woman in 1537, but she died less than two months after her arrival in Scotland.
- 4 Margaret's marriage to James IV was arranged by this treaty.
- 5 Margaret married James IV of Scotland by proxy at this place.
- 11 Margaret married Archibald Douglas, 6th Earl of as her second husband.
- 13 Margaret took this man as her third husband in 1528.
- 16 Margaret's cause of death.
