
Plots and rebellions in Elizabeth I's reign

- 5 The English naval commander who helped uncover the 1571 plot against Elizabeth I.
- 7 Mary, Queen of Scots was tried here after the failure of the 1586 plot.
- 8 This 1601 rebellion was led by Robert Devereux, former favourite of Elizabeth I.
- 9 Devereux and his supporters were against this royal advisor.
- 14 The plot of 1571 which took its name from a Florentine banker who was one of the conspirators.
