- 1 This man served Anne Boleyn as a chaplain and Elizabeth I as Archbishop of Canterbury.
- 2 This man served as Archbishop of Canterbury from 1503 to 1532.
- 3 This Archbishop of York was a cardinal and served as Henry VIII's Lord Chancellor.
- 4 Stephen Gardiner was Mary I's Lord Chancellor and bishop of this diocese.
- 5 John Fisher, martyr, cardinal and theologian, was bishop of this diocese.
- 6 This Bishop of Rochester and Worcester served Henry VII as Lord Chancellor.
- 7 This Marian Protestant martyr was Bishop of London.
- 8 Hugh Latimer, one of the Oxford Martyrs, was Bishop of this diocese.
- 9 This man was Bishop of Hereford and London and played a prominent role in the religious persecutions of Mary I's reign.
- 10 This Bishop of Hereford served as almoner to Queen Anne Boleyn and

preached a controversial sermon on Passion Sunday 1536.

- 11 This Bishop of Durham's career spanned the reigns of Henry VIII, Edward VI and Mary I, and he died in custody in Elizabeth I's reign.
- 12 This man served as Archbishop of Canterbury from 1583 to 1604.
- 13 This Bishop of Exeter was a Reformer and Bible translator.
- 14 This Bishop of Coventry and Lichfied officiated at the marriage of Henry VIII and Anne Boleyn on 25th January 1533.
- 15 This Archbishop of Canterbury helped Henry VIII get his marriage to Catherine of Aragon annulled.
- 16 This Archbishop of York served Mary I as Lord Chancellor and proclaimed Elizabeth I as queen on Mary's death.
- 17 This Bishop of Hereford served as Henry VIII's almoner and defended the king's supremacy with his treatise "De vera differentia regiae potestatis et ecclesiae".
