Castle was involved in the Pilgrimage of Grace in 1536.

- 10 Michael Joseph (An Gof) and Thomas Flamank rebelled in this county in 1497.
- 11 This rebel was hanged in chains in York for his part in the Pilgrimage of Grace.
- 12 This pretender claimed to be one of the Princes in the Tower and was involved in a rebellion in 1497.
- 13 The nickname of Thomas FitzGerald, 10th Earl of Kildare, who renounced his allegiance to Henry VIII and raised a rebellion in Ireland in 1534-5.
- 14 This Earl of Northumberland was involved in the 1569 Rising of the North.
