- 1 This George was hanged and burned at St Andrews, Scotland, on 1st March 1546 for his religious views and preaching.
- 2 This Thomas founded a famous library in Oxford and was born on 2nd March 1545.
- 3 This Lord Lisle suffered a fatal heart attack on hearing of his release from the Tower of London on 3rd March 1542.
- 4 This William was a spelling reformer and grammarian known for his 40-letter phonetic alphabet. He died on 4th March 1609.
- 5 The of the monasteries began on 6th March 1536.
- 6 This was observed and recorded by Paul Fabricius in March 1556.
- 7 Henry VIII was sent a courser and this creature in March 1516 by the Duke of Ferrara.
- 8 The maiden name of Lady Frances Radcliffe, Countess of Sussex, who died on 9th March 1589 and who served as one of Elizabeth I's ladies.
- 9 This Earl of Oxford died on 10th March 1513. He was a key figure in the Wars of the Roses and played an important role in the Battle of Bosworth Field.
- 10 This William was buried on 11th March 1609. He was described as "our English Homer" and wrote "Albion's England".
- 11 Cistercian monk William Haydock was

- executed on 12th March 1537 for his involvement in this.
- 12 This creature caused the death of Henry Bourchier, Earl of Essex, on 13th March 1540.
- 13 Sir John Russell, who died on 14th March 1555, served Henry VIII in this office, as well as Lord Privy Seal.
- 14 Henry VIII was recorded as using this on 15th March 1532 after William Warham, Archbishop of Canterbury, criticised him.
- 15 This Elizabethan actor and friend of Shakespeare died on 13th March 1619 and was buried on 16th March 1619.
- 16 This person featured in a terrifying vision or nightmare which reformer and theologian Alexander Alesius experienced. Alesius died on 17th march 1565.
- 17 The Lady Elizabeth, future Elizabeth I, was taken to the Tower of London on this feast day in 1554.
- 18 Elizabeth, Lady Cromwell, died on 19th March 1568. What was her maiden name?
- 19 Cuthbert Mayne, the Catholic martyr who was baptised on 20th March 1544, was charged with purchasing this and giving it to people in 1577.
- 20 This earl managed to get Queen Elizabeth I to move from lying on cushions to her bed on 21st March 1603.
- 21 This William, who was buried on 22nd March 1582, drew plans for a submarine and was a mathematician and gunner.
