- 1 This man executed in May 1536 was prominent in North Wales and Cheshire.
- 2 The court musician and groom of the privy chamber who was executed in May 1536.
- 3 The wife of George Boleyn.
- 4 George Boleyn, Lord, was executed in May 1536.
- 5 According to Justice Spelman's legal report, correspondence from this dead lady was used as evidence against Anne Boleyn.
- 6 Henry Norris held this office at his death in 1536.
- 7 This man executed in 1536 was made a Knight of the Bath at Anne Boleyn's coronation in 1533.
- 8 This diplomat and poet was arrested in May 1536 but later released.
- 9 This former chamberlain of Cardinal Wolsey was arrested in May 1536 but later released.
- 10 A man known as the Vicar of Hell, who was called to London for questioning in May 1536, but not arrested.
- 11 The mastermind behind the case against Anne Boleyn.
- 12 The Lord Chancellor who set up the commissions of oyer and terminer used to try four of the men in May 1536.
- 13 Henry Norris accused this man of deceiving him into making a confession which he then retracted.
- 14 The woman who was being "tutored" to appeal to the king.
- 15 The man who was elected to the Order of the Garter in April 1536 and who was said to be helping to tutor Henry VIII's new sweetheart.
- 16 This Marquess of Exeter was part of a group of Catholic conservatives working with Thomas Cromwell against Anne Boleyn. He also was a member of the jury at the Boleyns' trial.
- 17 This Tudor man presided over the trials of George and Anne Boleyn in May 1536.
- 18 This man collapsed after Anne's guilty verdict was given.
- 19 This Countess of Worcester was said to have spoken to her brother about Anne's inappropriate behaviour with a courtier and with her own brother.

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
