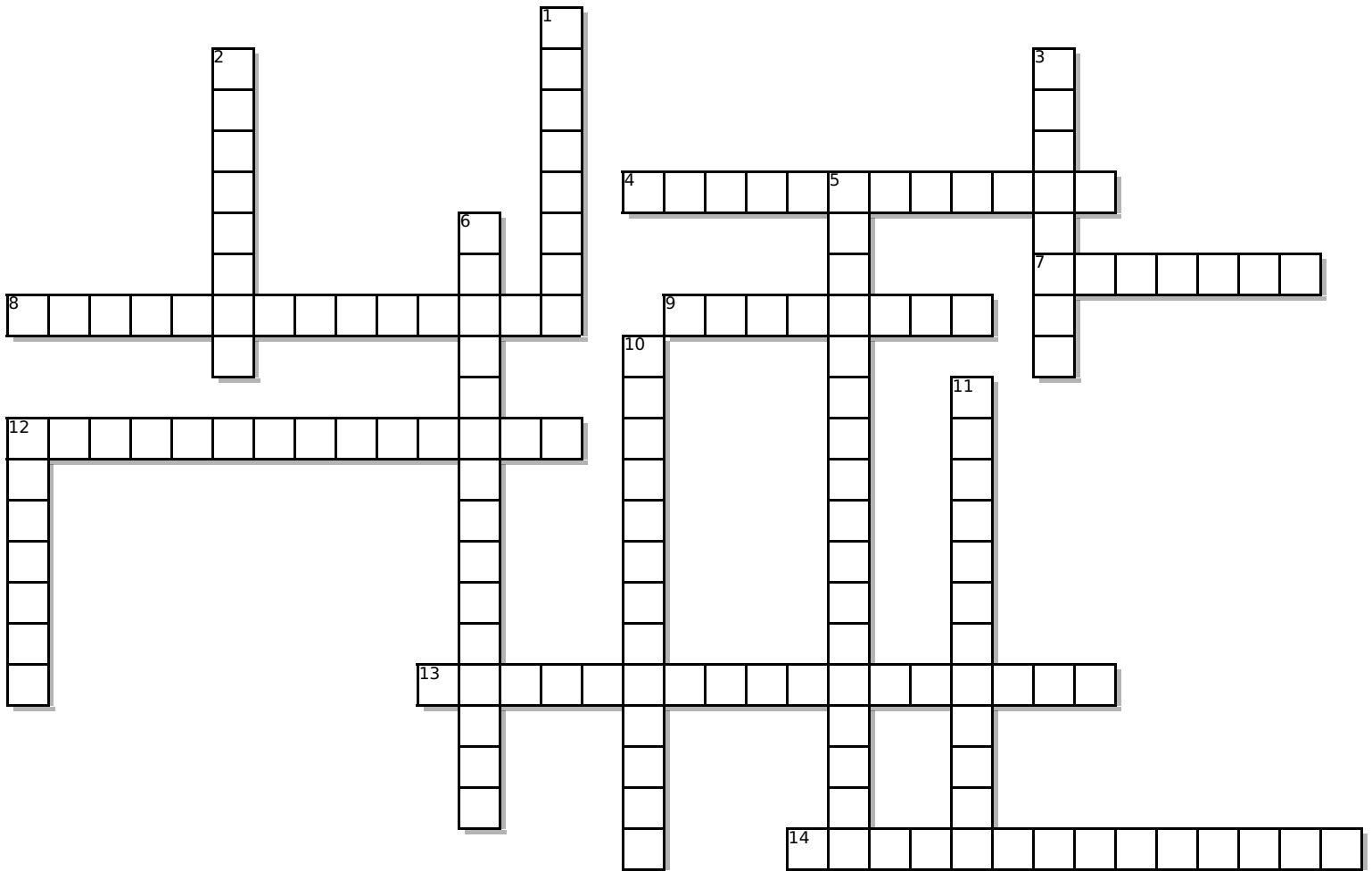


The Northeast Passage Voyage 1553
