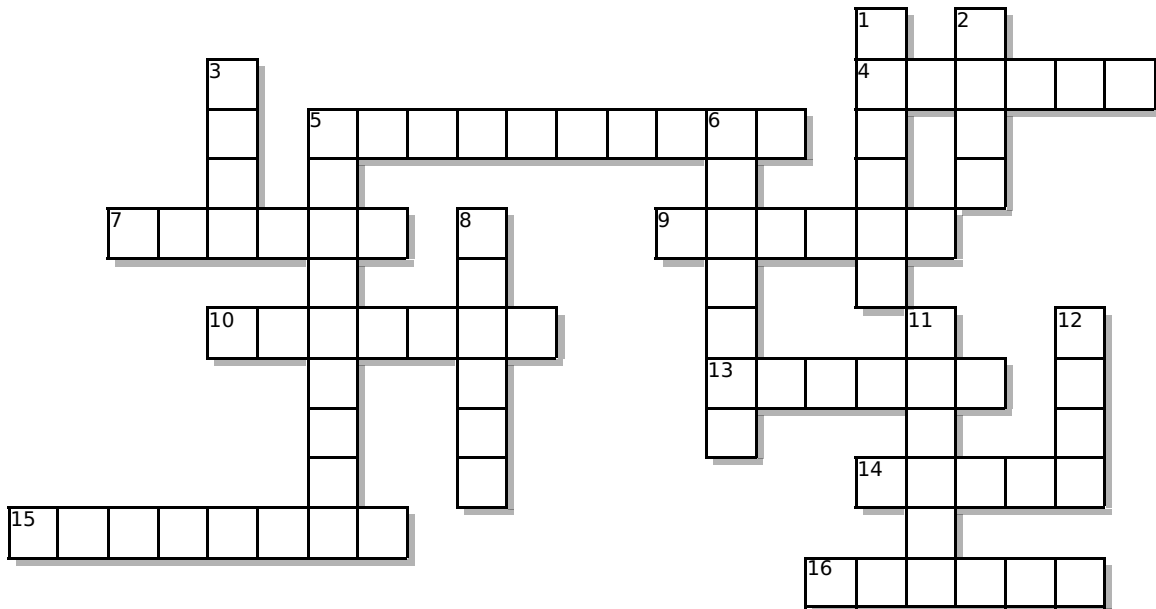


Tudor Catherines



ACROSS

- 4 This Tudor Catherine died in January 1536 at Kimbolton Castle.
- 5 This Tudor Catherine was married to Charles Brandon, Duke of Suffolk, and Richard Bertie.
- 7 This Catherine was the wife of pretender Perkin Warbeck and went on to serve Elizabeth of York and Mary, daughter of Henry VIII.
- 9 This Tudor Catherine was Elizabeth I's governess (married name).
- 10 This Tudor Catherine was the daughter of the 4th Baron Latimer and Lucy Somerset, the wife of Henry Percy, 8th Earl of Northumberland, and she served Queens Mary I and Elizabeth I.
- 13 This Tudor Catherine was married to Henry, Lord Herbert, and was a favourite of Queen Elizabeth I, who even loaned the Herberts one of her ships to travel in search of a cure for Catherine's illness.
- 14 This Tudor Catherine was married to Sir Francis Knollys and was the daughter of Mary Boleyn.
- 15 This Tudor Catherine was the mistress of Sir Edward Hoby and the mother of his illegitimate son, Peregrine.
- 16 This Tudor Catherine was twelve years old when she married Lord Henry Hastings, son of the Earl of Huntingdon, in a triple marriage ceremony on 25th May 1553.

- 1 This Catherine was the Abbess of Syon and died in Mechelen in 1576 after a mob attacked her monastery there.
- 2 This Tudor Catherine was the wife of Sir George Throckmorton and had 19 children with him, including Sir Nicholas Throckmorton and Sir Robert Throckmorton. Her granddaughter was Elizabeth (Bess) Throckmorton, wife of Sir Walter Raleigh.
- 3 This Tudor Catherine's husbands included Edward Burgh and John Neville, 3rd Baron Latimer.
- 5 This Catherine was married to Henry Stafford, Jasper Tudor and Sir Richard Wingfield.
- 6 This Tudor Catherine was the daughter of Honor Grenville, Lady Lisle, and served Anne of Cleves following the annulment of her marriage to Henry VIII.
- 8 The maiden name of the Tudor Catherine who was the first wife of Edward Seymour, brother of Jane Seymour.
- 11 This Tudor Catherine's mother was Jocasta Culpeper.
- 12 The maiden name of the Tudor Catherine who was imprisoned after she secretly married Edward Seymour, 1st Earl of Hertford and 1st Baron Beauchamp.
