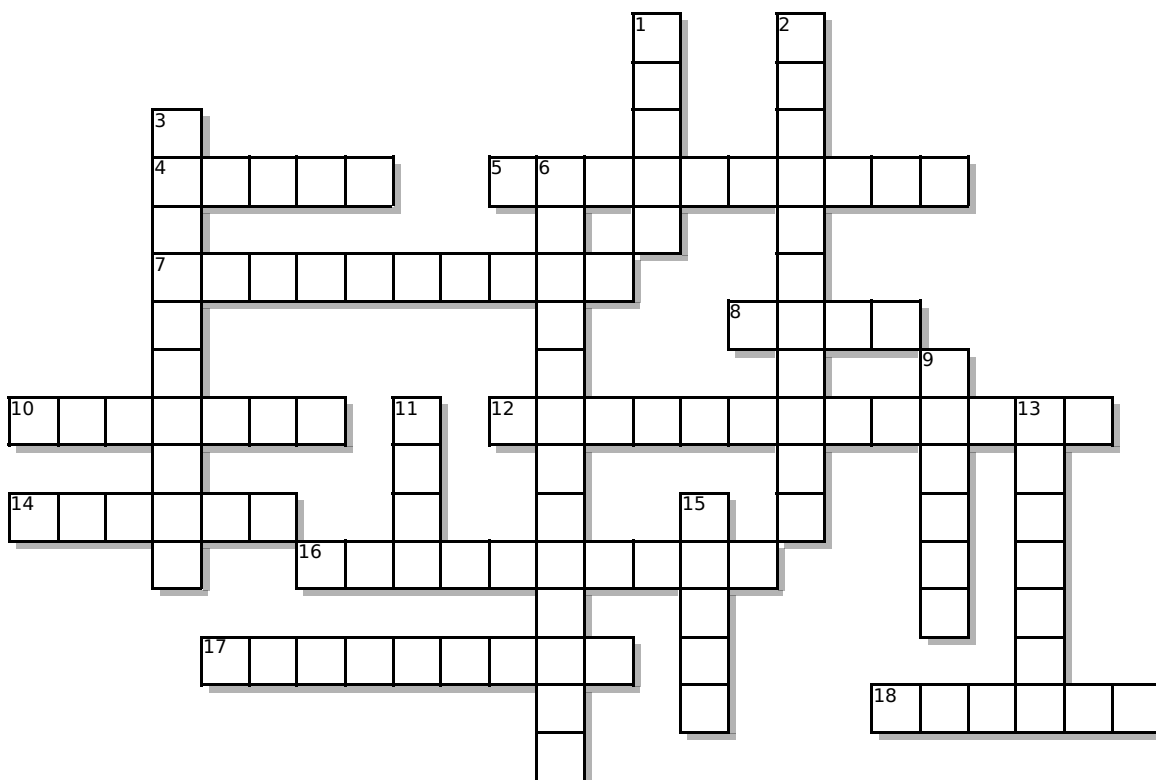


# July martyrs, saints and feast days

- 4 This Anne was burned for heresy on 16 July 1546.
- 5 Reformers John Frith and Andrew Hewet were burned for heresy here on 4 July 1533.
- 7 This saint and former Tudor Lord Chancellor was beheaded on 6 July 1535.
- 8 The northern city where Catholic martyrs William Anlaby, Thomas Warcop and Edward Fulthrop were executed on 4 July 1597.
- 10 Julins Palmer, John Gwyn, and Thomas Robyns were burned for sedition and heresy on 16 July 1556 and are known as the ..... Martyrs.
- 12 This saint and apostle, and patron saint of Spain, has his feast day on 25 July.
- 14 Catholic priest and martyr ..... Beesley was executed on 1 July 1591.
- 16 2 July is the Feast of the ..... of the Virgin.
- 17 The profession of John Copping who was executed on 5 July 1583 for dispersing "sundry seditious, schismatical and erroneous printed books".

- 18 Catholic priest and martyr John Boste was hanged, drawn and quartered in this northern city on 24 July 1594 after being accused of leaving and re-entering England without permission.
