- 1 The apothecary, alchemist and medium born in Worcester on 1st August 1555.
- 2 Edward Stafford, Duke of Buckingham, was granted a licence to found a college here on 2nd August 1514.
- 3 The blind Protestant martyr burnt at the stake in Derby on 1st August 1556.
- 4 Spaniards rampaged through towns in this county in August 1595.
- 5 The Earl of Bedford who led troops against the rebels of the Prayer Book Rebellion in August 1549.
- 6 Notorious Tudor rake, John de Vere, 16th Earl of Oxford, died at this Essex property on 3rd August 1562.
- 7 This woman was buried in Westminster Abbey on 4th August 1557.
- 8 Protestant martyr Richard Atkins was burnt here on 2nd August 1581.
- 9 John Ruthven, Earl of ....., and his brother Alexander, were killed as they allegedly tried to kidnap King James VI of Scotland on 5th August 1600.
- 10 Matthew Parker, Archbishop of Canterbury, was born in this city on 6th August 1504.
- 11 William Shakespeare's wife who died on 6th August 1623.
- 12 Mary, Queen of Scots, set sail for France from this place on 7th August 1548.
- 13 Margaret Tudor and King James IV of Scotland married at this chapel on 8th August 1503.
- 14 This man officiated at Edward VI's funeral at Westminster Abbey on 8th August 1553.
- 15 Elizabeth I gave a famous speech here on 9th August 1588.
- 16 Elizabeth I was in this city on 9th August 1561 when she issued a royal mandate forbidding women to reside in cathedrals and colleges.
- 17 William Horne, who was executed on 4th August 1540, was the last of the monks of this order to be executed for refusing to accept Henry VIII's supremacy.
- 18 Around 900 rebel prisoners were massacred here on 5th August 1549 in the Prayer Book Rebellion.
- 19 Margaret Tudor married this man in secret on 6th August 1514.
- 20 The name of mariner, cartographer and landowner who was an illegitimate son of one of Elizabeth I's favourites and who was born on 7th August 1574.
