- 6 Italian Humanist scholar Andreas Ammonius died of this on 17 August 1517.
- 7 This man was arrested on 29 August 1538 and was the son of a countess and brother of a cardinal.
- 8 Thomas Howard, 3rd Duke of Norfolk, died a natural death here on 26 August 1554.
