- 1 Built in 1510, launched in 1511, rebuilt in 1536 and sank in 1545.
- 2 The was the caravel that John Cabot sailed from Bristol on his 1497 voyage, when he is thought to have landed at Newfoundland.
- 3 Built in 1510, this ship named after a saint and Catherine of Aragon's badge was last mentioned in the records in 1558.
- 4 This English carrack was Henry VIII's flagship and was also known as The Great Harry.
- 5 The was a race-built galleon built in 1577 and sailed by Sir Francis Drake in the Battle of Gravelines in 1588.
- 6 A 47-gun galleon commanded by Sir Francis Drake in his 1587 "singeing of the King of Spain's beard" attack on Cadiz.
- 7 Also known as the Ark and Ark Raleigh, this galleon was ordered by Sir Walter Raleigh and was used against the Spanish Armada.

- 8 The was the original name of the Golden Hind, the galleon captained by Sir Francis Drake in his circumnavigation of the world.
- 9 The was the ship used by Henry VIII and Anne Boleyn on their 1532 trip to Calais.
- 10 The was the 120 ton flagship sailed by Thomas Cavendish for his 1586-8 circumnavigation of the globe.
- 11 Tudor writer and historian William Strachey was aboard this ship when it ran aground in a hurricane in 1609.
- 12 The ship sailed by Stephen Borough in 1556 when he discovered Novaya Zemlya and the Viagatz Strait (Kara Strait), which was named the Burrough Strait until the late 1800s.
- 13 The Nuestra Señora del was a Spanish ship captured on 1st August 1588 by the English fleet.
- 14 Marie la was a French ship used in the 1512 Battle of Saint-Mathieu.
