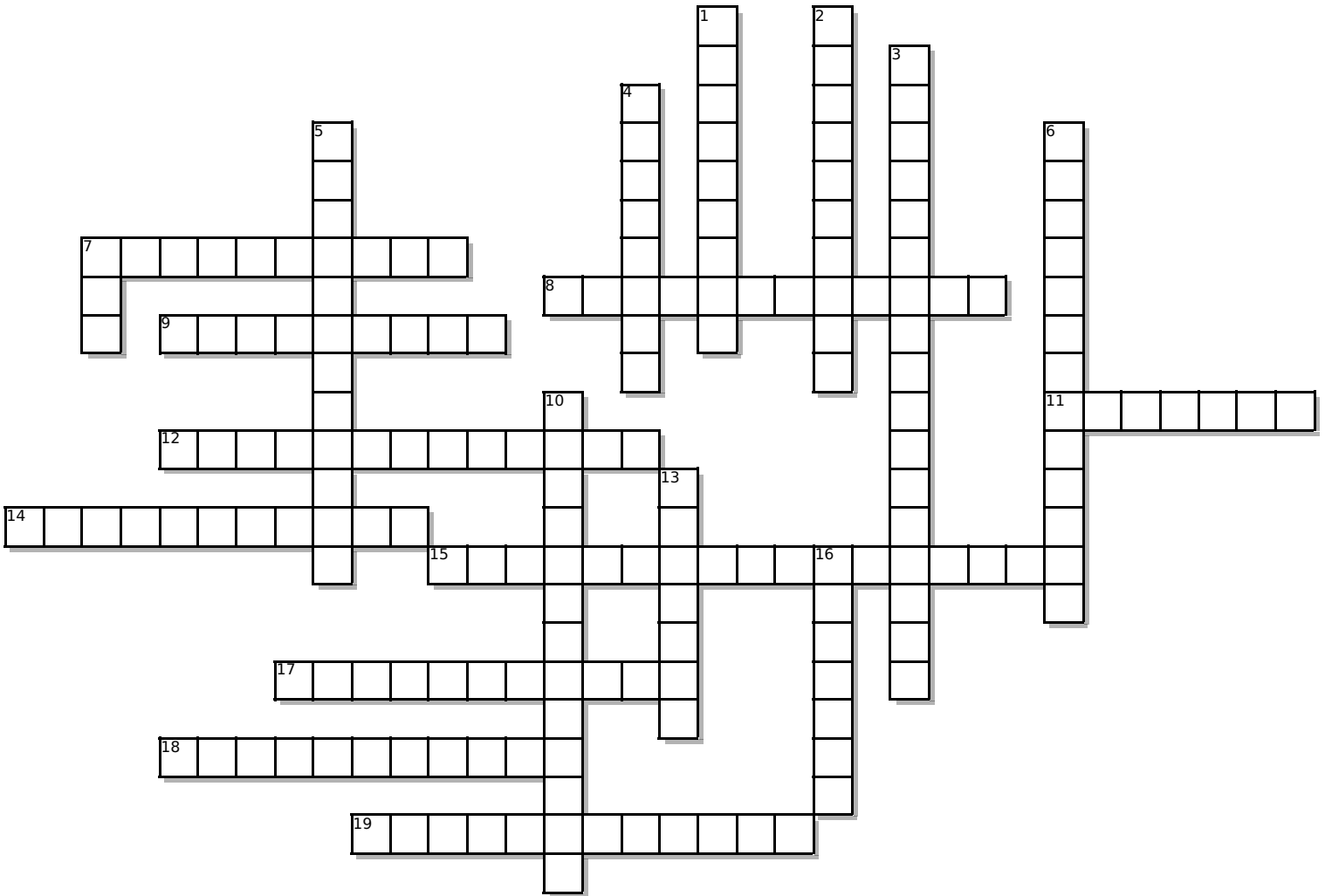


The Stuarts



ACROSS

- 7 James V died shortly after the Scots' defeat at this battle in 1542.
- 8 James V's second wife.
- 9 Mary, Queen of Scots, was betrothed to Prince Edward, future Edward VI, by this treaty in 1543.
- 11 Mary, Queen of Scots, married the of France in 1558.
- 12 James VI's wife.
- 14 The name of the war between England and Scotland which was caused by Scotland's rejection of the marriage treaty tying Mary, Queen of Scots, to Edward VI.
- 15 James V's first wife who died after just 6 months of marriage.
- 17 This man served as Secretary of State under Elizabeth I and James I.
- 18 Mary, Queen of Scots, married this Lord Darnley in 1565.
- 19 Mary, Queen of Scots, was executed here in February 1587.

DOWN

- 1 Mary, Queen of Scots, was imprisoned here when she was forced to abdicate in favour of her son.
- 2 This palace was the birthplace of Mary, Queen of Scots, and her father, James V.
- 3 This person wanted to send James IV's head to Henry VIII in France.
- 4 James IV married this daughter of King Henry VII.
- 5 Work written by James VI in 1597 on necromancy.
- 6 James IV married the daughter of Henry VII at the chapel here on 8th August 1503.
- 7 Mary, Queen of Scots was just days old when she became queen in 1542.
- 10 The name of the documents which were produced as evidence against Mary, Queen of Scots, allegedly proving her collusion with the Earl of Bothwell in Darnley's murder.
- 13 James I combined the rose and in his royal badge.
- 16 James IV was killed at this battle in 1513.
