- 1 Elizabeth I's starsign.
- 2 The palace in which Elizabeth I was born on 7th September 1533.
- 3 Elizabeth's mother.
- 4 This clergyman stood as a godfather at her christening in September 1533.
- 5 The woman who served as Elizabeth's first lady governess when Elizabeth was a baby.
- 6 Elizabeth's second governess who went on to be her good friend and Lady of the Bedchamber.
- 7 One of Elizabeth's tutors.
- 8 Another of Elizabeth's tutors.
- 9 Elizabeth joined this woman's household following the death of Henry VIII.
- 10 This man acted inappropriately with the teenaged Elizabeth, and his behaviour could be seen as sexual abuse.
- 11 In 1548, Elizabeth was sent away to this man and his wife's household to protect her reputation.
- 12 Elizabeth was arrested in 1554 after being implicated in this uprising.
- 13 The feast day on which Elizabeth was escorted to the Tower of London in 1554.
- 14 The famous letter that Elizabeth wrote in March 1554 which delayed her imprisonment by one day.
- 15 Following her imprisonment in the Tower, in May 1554 Elizabeth was released into house arrest at this palace.
- 16 The man who supervised Elizabeth's house arrest.
- 17 The Welshman who served as Elizabeth's cofferer while she was under house arrest and, when she was queen, comptroller of her household.
- 18 In 1555, Elizabeth was allowed to return to her estate here rather than return to house arrest.
- 19 Elizabeth was said to be reading under this type of tree when she received news of her accession.
- 20 Elizabeth was recorded as reciting a verse from this book of the Bible after she received news that she was queen.
