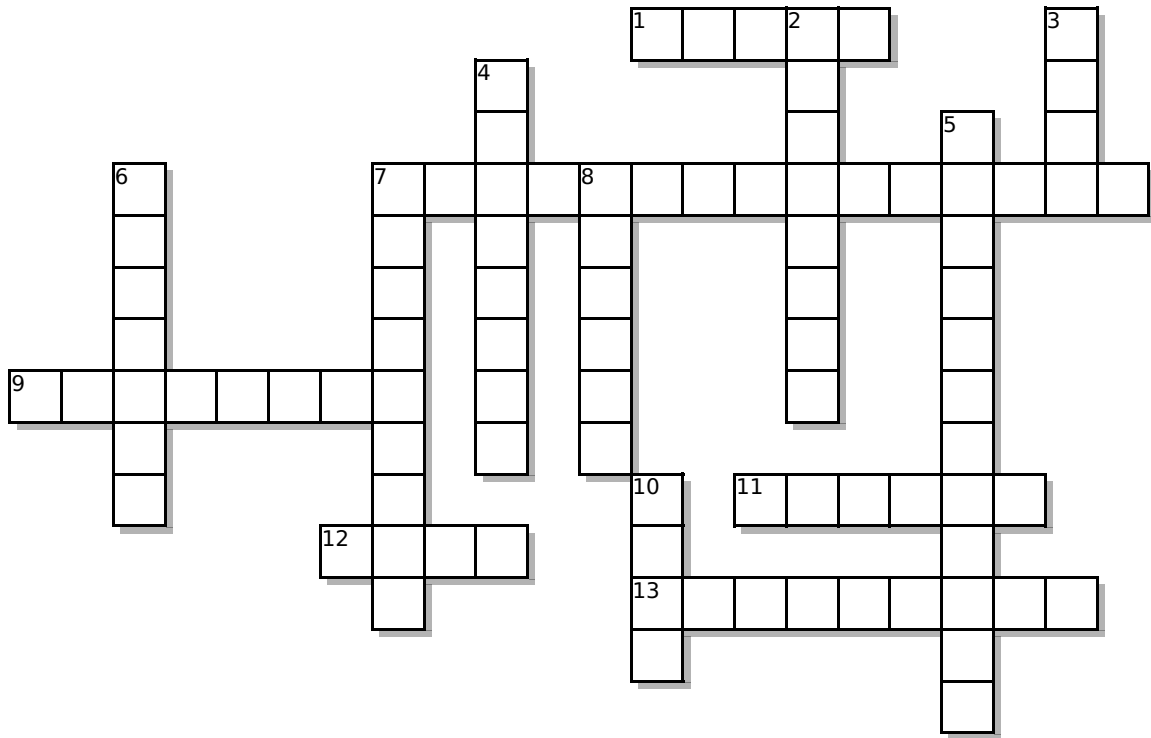


Christmas Carols Crossword
