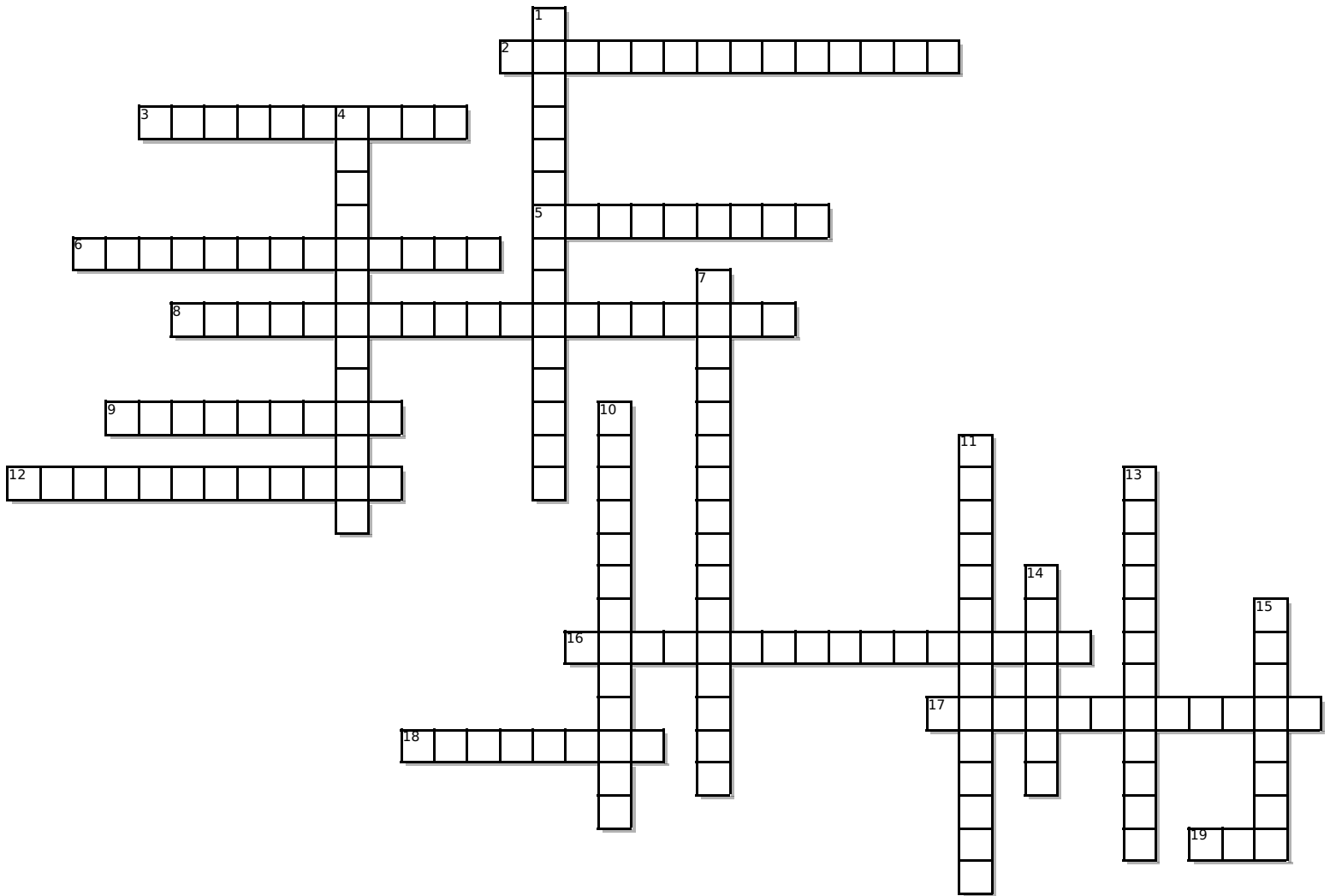


# January Births and Deaths



## ACROSS

- 2 The Bible translator who died on 20th January 1569.
- 3 This Duchess of Feria and former favourite of Mary I was born on 6th January 1538.
- 5 Henry Howard, Earl of Surrey, was executed for treason here on 19th January 1547.
- 6 This Tudor soldier, courtier and diplomat, who died on 27th January 1510, served Henry VII as Master of the Horse and Henry VIII as Warden and Chief Justice of the Royal Forests to the south of Trent.
- 8 This Tudor prince was born on New Year's Day 1511.
- 9 Henry VIII died at this palace on 28th January 1547.
- 12 This author of "The lyfe of Sir Thomas Moore, knighte" died on 4th January 1578.
- 16 This artist known for paintings including the Ditchley Portrait of Elizabeth I died on 19th January 1636.
- 17 This Tudor scholar, diplomat and founder of a famous library died in London on 29th January 1613.
- 18 This French king died on New Year's Day 1515.

- 19 Agnes Bowker allegedly gave birth to this on 17th January 1569 in Leicestershire.

- 1 Catherine of Aragon died here on 7th January 1536.
- 4 This Tudor geographer and poet was born on 5th January 1546.
- 7 This lady gave birth to a future king on 28th January 1457.
- 10 This Jesuit was hanged, drawn and quartered on 1st December 1581. He was canonised in 1970.
- 11 This imperial ambassador died at Louvain on 21st January 1556.
- 13 This Lord Chancellor, politician, philosopher, author, scientist and "Father of the Scientific method" was born on 22nd January 1561 at York House in the Strand, London.
- 14 Edward Barton, who died on 28th January 1598, was Elizabeth I's ambassador to this empire.
- 15 Edward Seymour, Lord Protector, was executed on 22nd January 1552, but what was his dukedom?
