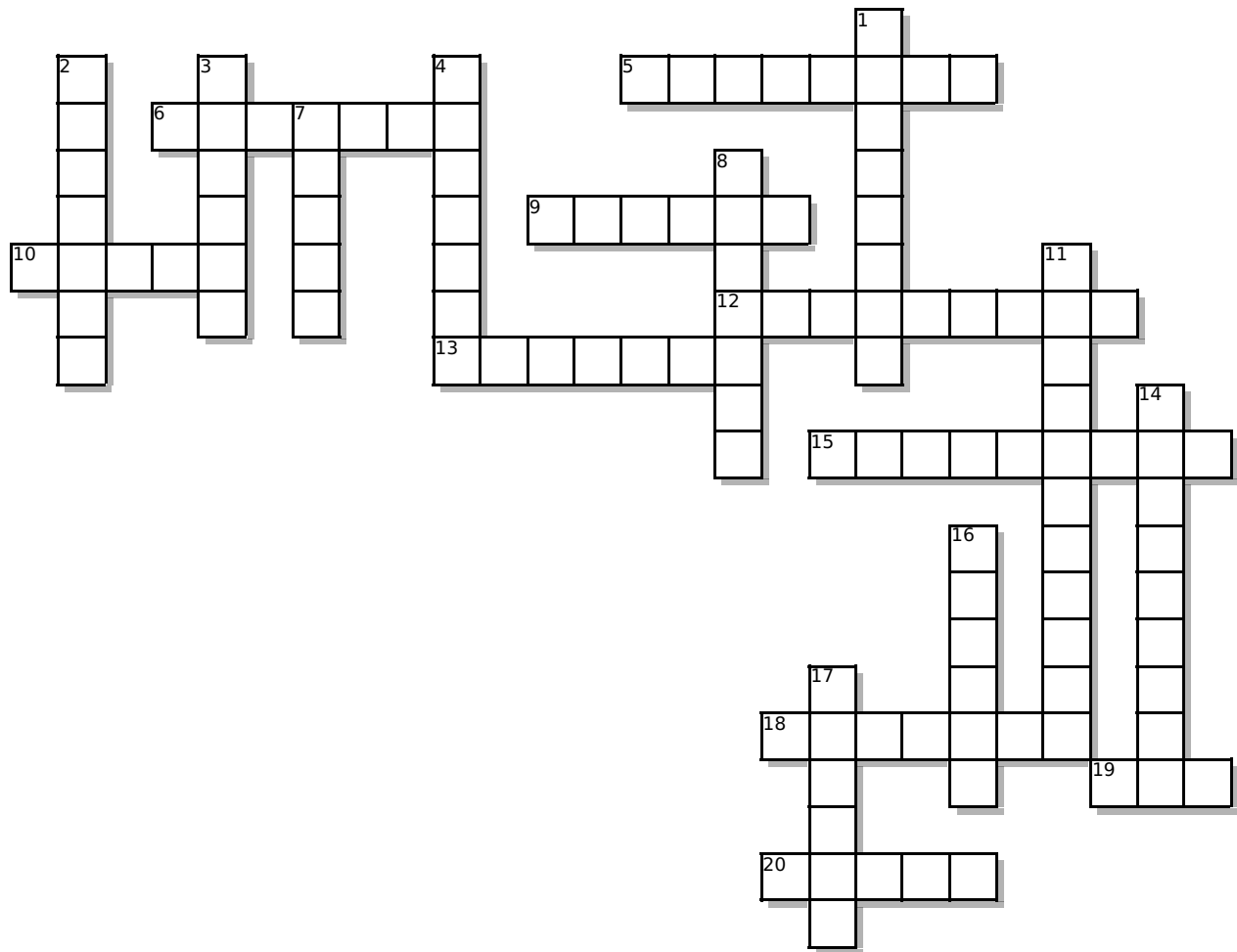


Tudor Henrys Crossword Puzzle



ACROSS

- 5 This Tudor Henry was Earl of Arundel, served on the jury at the trials of Anne and George Boleyn, and served Mary I as Lord Steward of The Household.
- 6 This Tudor Henry was a Jesuit who was hanged, drawn and quartered in York in 1593.
- 9 Lady Jane Grey's father, Henry Grey, was Marquess of before becoming Duke of Suffolk.
- 10 This Henry and Baron Hunsdon was made a ward of Anne Boleyn and became a favourite in Elizabeth I's reign.
- 12 This Henry was Earl of Essex and died after falling off his horse in 1540.
- 13 This Tudor Henry was taken hostage during the Pilgrimage of Grace rebellion to ensure his father's co-operation with the rebels.
- 15 This Henry, who was Marquess of Exeter, was beheaded in December 1538 for alleged treasonous correspondence with Cardinal Pole.
- 18 This Tudor Henry was Duke of Richmond and Somerset and died in 1536.
- 19 This Tudor Henry was Queen Elizabeth I's champion and the son of Margaret Wyatt.
- 20 This Tudor Henry served Henry VII as Archbishop of Canterbury, Chancellor of Ireland, Deputy Governor for Prince Henry, and Keeper of the Great Seal.

- 1 This Tudor Henry was 2nd Earl of Cumberland and was married to Eleanor Brandon.
- 2 Henry Pole, who was executed for alleged treasonous correspondence with his brother, Cardinal Pole, in 1539, was Baron.....
- 3 This Tudor Henry was a merchant-tailor, citizen of London and diarist.
- 4 Margaret Tudor's third husband, Henry Stewart, was 1st Lord
- 7 This Tudor Henry was known as the Wizard Earl.
- 8 This Tudor Henry was 2nd Earl of Pembroke and patron of the theatre company Pembroke's Men.
- 11 On which special day in 1511 was Henry, Duke of Cornwall, King Henry VIII's son, born?
- 14 This Tudor Henry was 2nd Earl of Essex, son of Elizabeth Stafford and husband to Elizabeth Howard and Anne Calthorpe.
- 16 This Tudor Henry was a poet who got into trouble for smashing windows and shooting prostitutes with stonebows in 1543.
- 17 This Henry was married to Mary Dudley, who was badly disfigured from smallpox after nursing Queen Elizabeth I.

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
