
## March Births and Deaths

- Anne of Denmark died of this illness and consumption on 2 March 1619.
- 7 This George was hanged and burnt on 1 March 1546 in St Andrews and Scotland after denouncing the pope and continuing to preach. This Grand Prior of the Order of St John died on 1 March 1559.
- 13 The first name of Bishop Stephen Gardiner's nephew, who was executed on 7 March 1544.
  16 Arthur Brooke was killed in a shipwreck on 19 March 563, but what famous story (and later play) did he write the first version in English
- 17 This actor died on 13 March 1619. 18 Thomas Howard, 4th Duke of Norfolk, was born here on 10 March 1538.
- 20 Cardinal Reginald Pole's traditional birthdate is 3 March 1500, but where was he born?
- 21 Arthur, Lord Lisle, died on 4 March 1542 in the Tower of London. Who was his father?
- 22 This twice-married Duchess of Suffolk's traditional birthdate is 22 March 1519.
