
June Feast Days



ACROSS

- 7 This feast, also known as Pentecost, is celebrated on 7th Sunday after Easter, so is May or June.
- 9 St Elmo is the patron saint of this ailment, as well as being the patron saint of sailors.
- 10 This would be set alight at Midsummer and rolled down a hill to predict whether or not there would be a good harvest.
- 11 St Elmo, whose feast day is celebrated on 2nd June, is one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers whose intercession is believed to be particularly effective against
- 12 Midsummer is the pagan celebration of this.
- 13 St Barnabas was martyred in Cyprus in 61 AD, but how was he killed? He was
- 14 At Midsummer, girls would throw

these over their shoulders to see the form of their future husband.

DOWN

- 1 Midsummer fires were thought to ward off these.
- 2 This saint's feast day on 24th June coincided with Midsummer.
- 3 The Feast of St Peter and Paul on 29th June was the traditional time for this ceremony.
- 4 St Elmo was said to have been fed by this creature while living in solitude at Mount Lebanon.
- 5 According to legend, St Elmo carried on preaching when this struck the ground next to him.
- 6 St Elmo's Day was the traditional time for doing this farming job.
- 8 This saint's feast day is celebrated on 11th June and churches would be decorated with garlands of flowers.
