
August Feast Days and Martyrs

- 2 This Roman Catholic martyr was hanged, drawn and quartered at St Paul's Churchyard on 8th August 1570.
- 4 Robert was burnt at Ipswich on 31st August 1555.
- 8 This ancient Celtic festival, also known as Loaf Mass, marked the start of the wheat harvest and was on 1st August.
- 9 This Protestant martyr was burnt at Rome on 2nd August 1581.
- 11 15th August is the Feast of the of the Virgin/Our Lady.
- 12 Brother, one of the Carthusian Martyrs, was hanged, drawn and quartered at Tyburn on 4th August 1540.
- 13 The ruler who ordered the beheading of 29th August's saint did it because it was the birthday wish of his step-daughter,

- 14 Roman Catholic martyrs Friar Conn O'Rourke and Patrick O'Healy, Bishop of Mayo were executed in this Irish county on 13th August 1579.
- 15 Who/what appeared to St Peter and helped him escape imprisonment.
