- 5 This wife of John Dudley, Duke of Northumberland, served Anne of Cleves and Catherine Parr.
- 6 This lady ended up on the scaffold with her royal mistress in 1542.
- 7 Catherine Howard's half-sister who attended on the queen during her confinement at Syon and in the Tower.
- 8 Elizabeth Oxenbridge, Lady, served Jane Seymour, Catherine Howard and Catherine Parr.

- 9 This Countess of Worcester served Anne Boleyn and also was said to have accused the queen of inappropriate behaviour.
- 10 This woman served Anne Boleyn and was also the mistress of Anne's uncle, the Duke of Norfolk.
- 11 This Margery served Catherine of Aragon, Anne Boleyn and Jane Seymour.
- 12 This Countess of Pembroke started her royal service serving Jane Seymour and her mother was one of Catherine of Aragon's ladies.
- 13 This daughter of Honor, Lady Lisle, was eventually taken into the service of Queen Jane Seymour.
- 14 This young woman served Mary I even though her sister was in the Tower of London.
- 15 This woman, also known as Lady Knollys, was the cousin of Elizabeth I and served as Chief Lady of the Bedchamber.
- 16 This lady of Elizabeth I got into trouble for secretly marrying Walter Ralegh.
