
Mary I Places



ACROSS

- 3 Mary was sent here in late 1533 to serve in her half-sister Elizabeth's household.
- Birthplace of Mary I.
- This manor in Hertfordshire was one of Mary's main preaccession residences.
- Mary and her half-siblings, Edward and Elizabeth, all spent time at this castle with Norman origins, and she was granted it during her brother's reign.
- 10 Mary wrote to the privy council from this manor in July 1553 ordering them to proclaim her as Edward VI's successor.
- 11 Mary married Philip of Spain here on 25th July 1554.
- 12 This house, also known as Bewdley Manor, was also a residence of Mary during her time presiding over the

Council of Wales and the Marches.

13 Mary was crowned queen here on 1st October 1553.

14 Mary died here on 17th November 1558.

- 1 Mary gave a rousing speech to the citizens of London
- here during Wyatt's Rebellion in 1554.

 Mary took to her chambers here in 1555 believing she would soon give birth.
