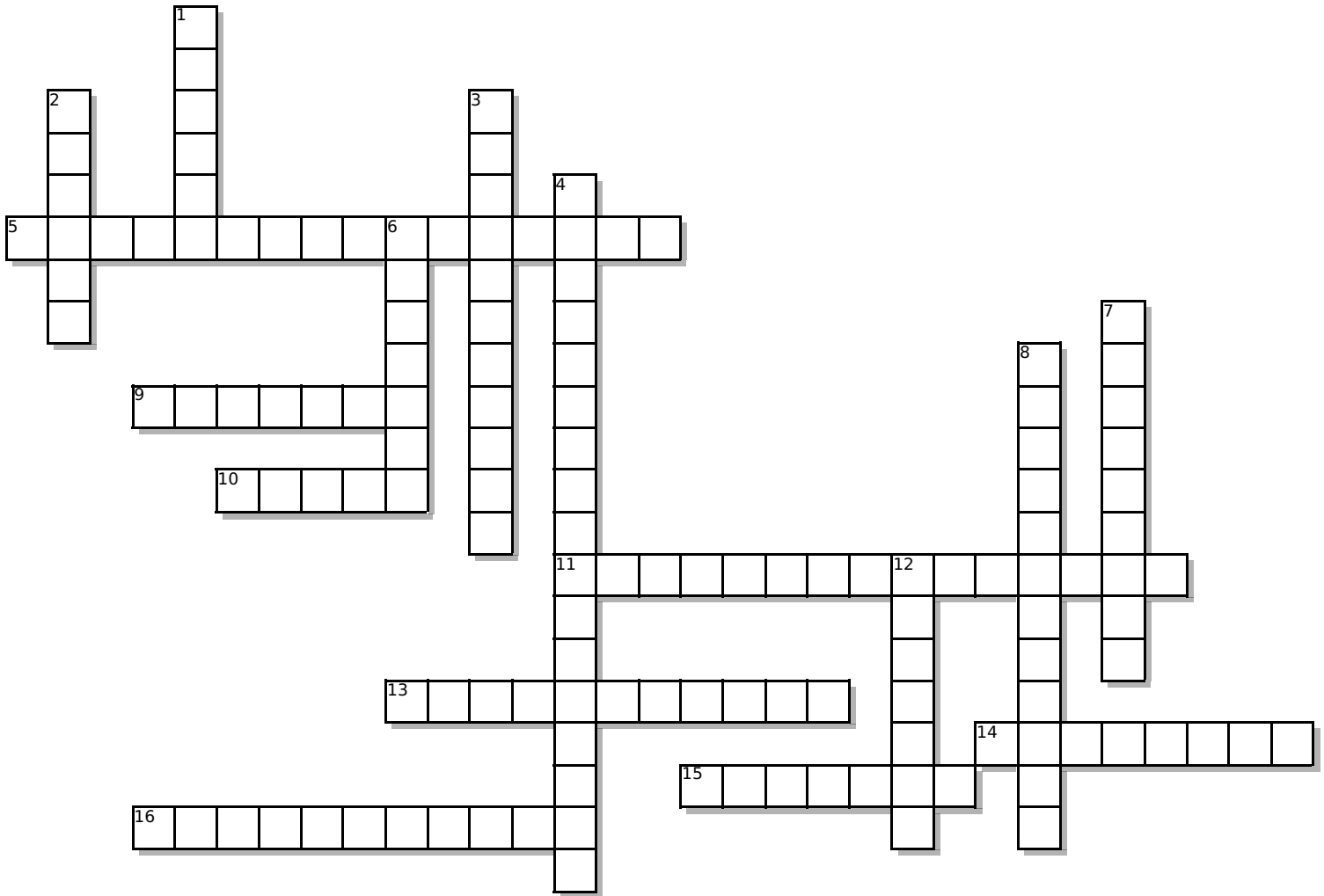


Tudor Navy

- 11 This 1500 ton carrack, the first English two-decker, was launched in 1514.
- 13 This is a record of the ships that made up the Tudor navy in the 1540s and was created by Anthony Anthony.
- 14 This ship was chosen as the English flagship at the 1512 Battle of Saint-Mathieu.
- 15 A small, usually 2-masted, ship of 20-40 tons.
- 16 Henry VII commissioned the oldest

surviving dry dock here in 1495.
