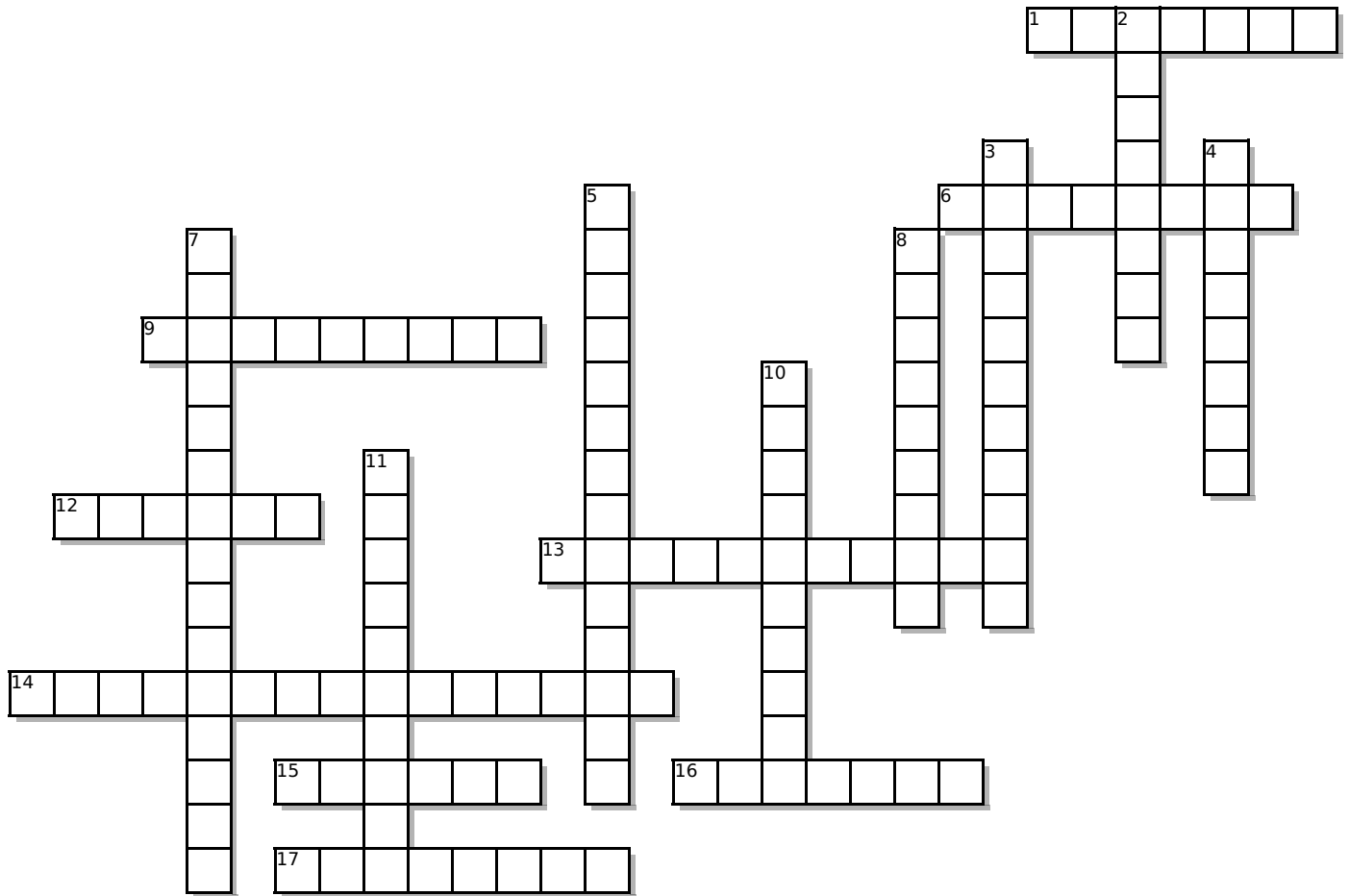


# World Rulers in the Tudor Period

- 12 The House of ..... was on the French throne from 1422 to 1589.
- 13 This Holy Roman Emperor was the husband of Mary of Burgundy and the father of Philip of Castile and Margaret of Austria.
- 14 The Holy Roman Emperors of the 15th to 18th centuries were from this dynasty.
- 15 This Russian tsar wrote a rather rude letter to Elizabeth I.
- 16 This Swedish monarch was one of Elizabeth I's suitors for several years.
- 17 Henry VIII was concerned about how his calves compared to this French king.

- 2 Elizabeth I had friendly relations with this Ottoman sultan.
- 3 This Danish king apprehended the Earl of Bothwell, Mary, Queen of Scots' third husband, and had him imprisoned.
- 4 Henry VIII's youngest sister, Mary, married this French king in 1514.
- 5 The St Bartholomew's Day Massacre took place a few days after the marriage of Margaret of Valois and this Protestant king, who would become King of France.
- 7 This ruler of the Florentine Republic was the patron of men like Botticelli and Michelangelo, the father of Pope Leo X, and was known as The Magnificent.
- 8 This Spanish queen and her husband are known for their "Reconquista", for the Spanish Inquisition, for financing Christopher Columbus, and for bringing the two main kingdoms of Spain together.
- 10 Charles V abdicated as Holy Roman Emperor in 1556 in favour of his brother, who became .....
- 11 This royal house ruled Spain from 1479 to 1555.
