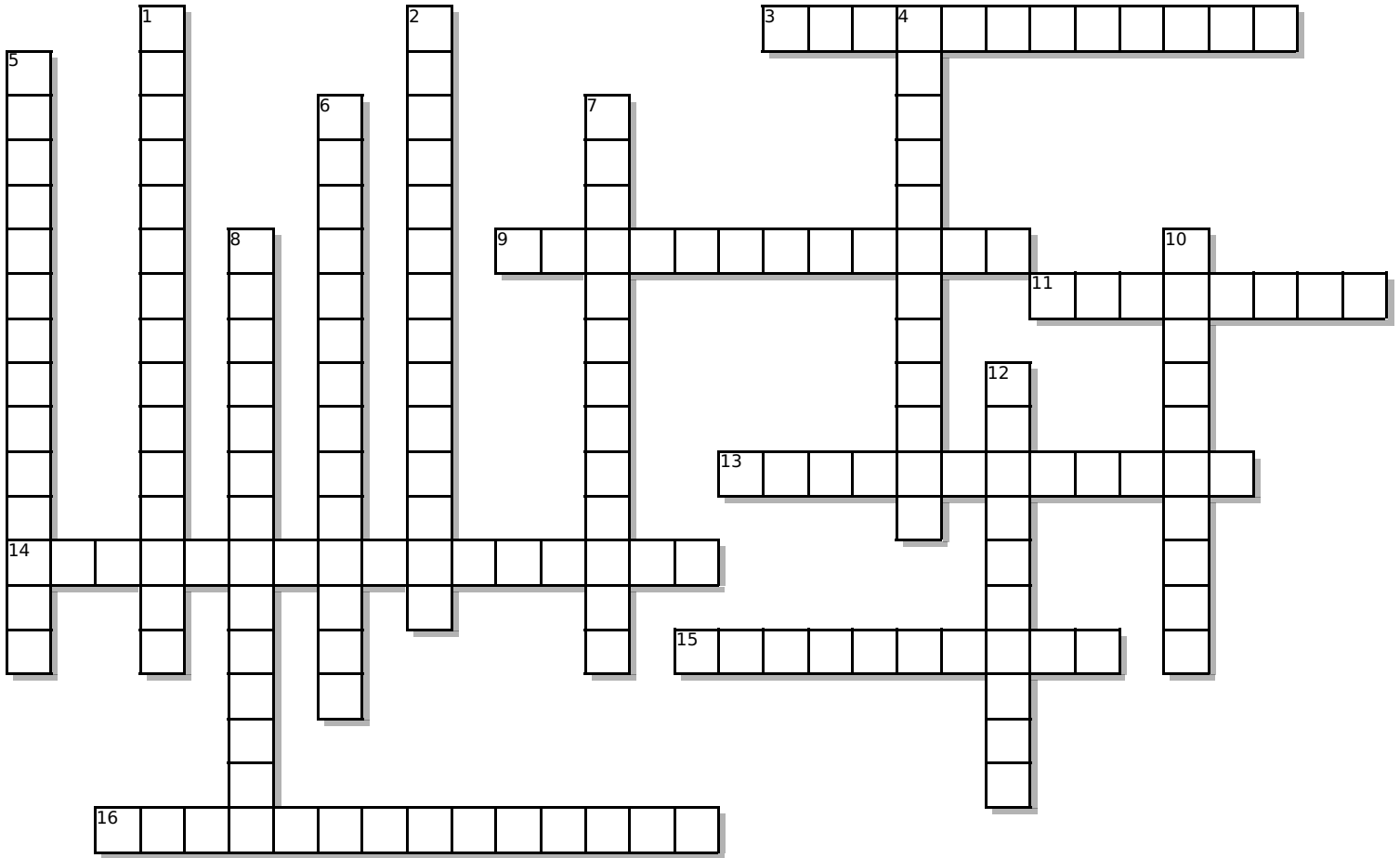


Tudor Mistresses and Bastards

- 3 According to the Prince Tudor Theory, Elizabeth I had an illegitimate son, Henry Wriothesley, with this man.
- 9 The recognised illegitimate son of Henry VIII.
- 11 Arthur, Lord Lisle, Lord Deputy of Calais in Henry VIII's reign, was the illegitimate son of an unknown woman and this royal.
- 13 This member of Queen Anne Boleyn's household is alleged to have had a romance with the king in around 1535.
- 14 Some say that this man fathered by a Breton woman was the illegitimate son of Henry VII.
- 15 This Baron Hunsdon is thought by some to have been fathered by Henry VIII.
- 16 This French maid of honour was alleged to have slept with King Henry VIII.

- 1 King Henry VIII denied rumours that he had slept with this woman.
- 2 This Chief Lady of Elizabeth I's Bedchamber is believed by some to have been fathered by Henry VIII.
- 4 This man turned up in Spain in the 1580s claiming to be Elizabeth I's illegitimate son.
- 5 A poet and playwright whose mother, Agnes, allegedly slept with Henry VIII at the hunting lodge at North Petherton.
- 6 This son of Jane Pollard, who became a soldier and privateer, is believed by author Philippa Jones to be a son of Henry VIII.
- 7 The mother of the alleged illegitimate daughter brought up by the king's tailor.
- 8 According to Sir John Harington, Henry VIII entrusted his tailor with the care of this girl, his illegitimate daughter.
- 10 This woman was Henry VIII's mistress at some point before he married her sister.
- 12 The son of Mary Berkeley who some believe to have been a son of Henry VIII and who was saved from serious trouble numerous times by Elizabeth I.
