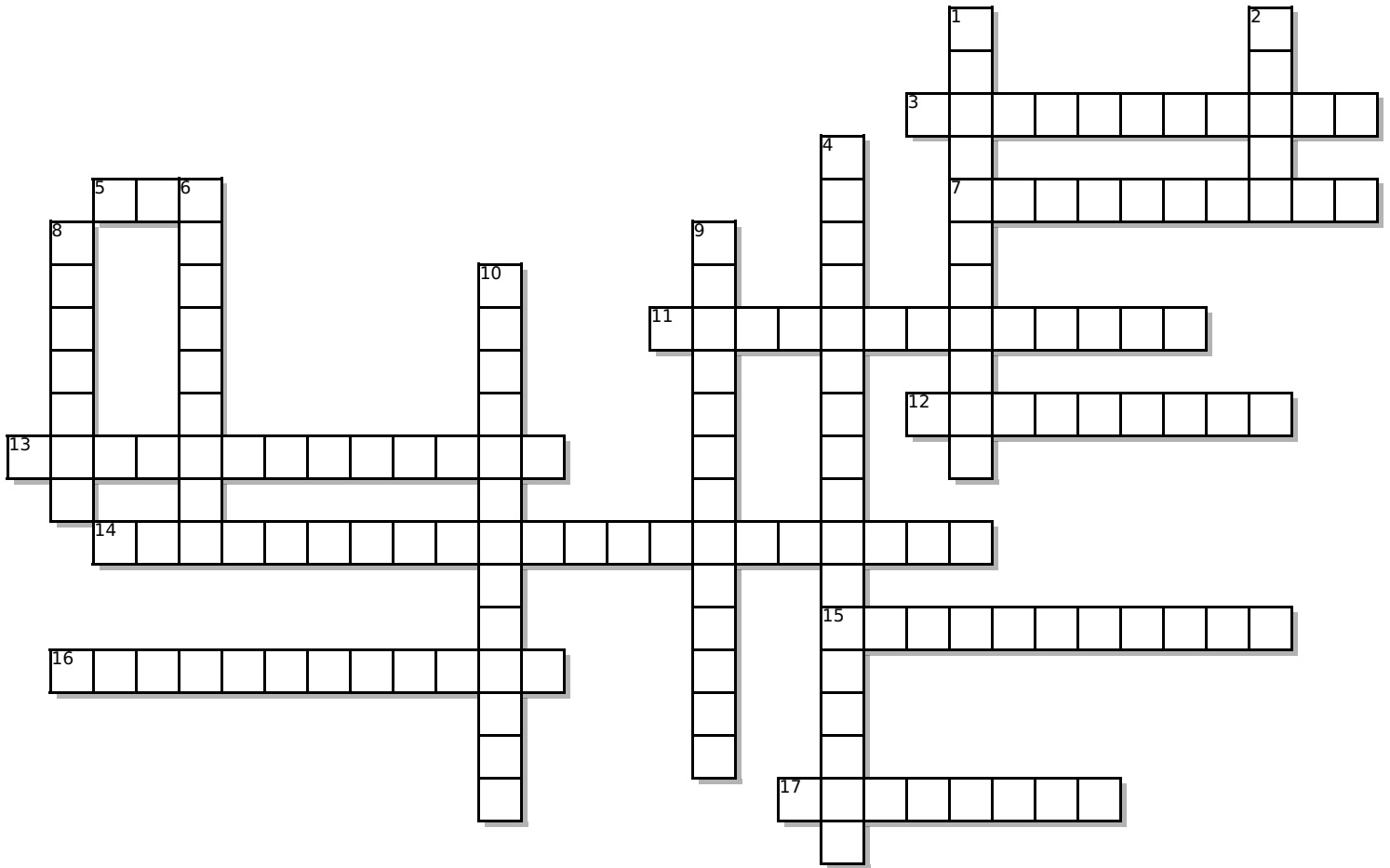


Elizabeth I's Early Life



ACROSS

- 3 This man served in the young Elizabeth's household and later became her Comptroller of the Household
- 5 Elizabeth's age when her mother died
- 7 At the age of just 11, Elizabeth translated from French "The Mirror of the" for Catherine Parr
- 11 Elizabeth was confined here for a couple of months following her arrest in March 1554
- 12 Elizabeth was released from prison in May 1554 to house arrest at this place
- 13 Elizabeth's first governess
- 14 This woman was appointed as Elizabeth's governess in 1557
- 15 This man, formerly her brother Edward's tutor, taught Elizabeth from 1548
- 16 Catherine Parr sent Elizabeth away from her

- household to this man's house in 1548
- 17 Elizabeth was at her estate here when she found out she was queen

- 1 This man and his wife were in charge of the joint household of Mary and Elizabeth following Elizabeth's birth
- 2 Elizabeth I's birthsign
- 4 This Marchioness of Exeter was one of Elizabeth's godmothers
- 6 Elizabeth was christened at the Church of the Friars at Greenwich
- 8 This William was one of Elizabeth's tutors
- 9 This man was reported as acting very inappropriately (at best!) with Elizabeth when she lived with Catherine Parr
- 10 This cleric was Elizabeth's godfather
