- 1 This Anne was a Protestant martyr who was tortured and then burnt in 1546.
- 2 The maiden name of Anne Bacon, translator, scholar and mother of Francis Bacon.
- 3 This Anne was the daughter of Honor, Lady Lisle, and served as a maid of honour to Queen Jane Seymour.
- 4 This Anne served Elizabeth I as a maid of honour and was the first wife of Edward de Vere, Earl of Oxford.
- 5 This Anne was the Thousand Day Queen.
- 6 This Anne was William Shakespeare's wife.
- 7 This Anne was the first wife of William Parr, Marquess of Northampton.
- 8 This Anne was married to Edward Seymour, Duke of Somerset and Lord Protector.
- 9 This Anne was the daughter of the Duke of Suffolk and he secured a place for her at Margaret of Austria's court.
- 10 This Anne was a lady-in-waiting in Henry VIII's reign and married William Herbert, 1st Earl of Pembroke.
- 11 This Anne was a maid of honour to Elizabeth I and a mistress to Edward de Vere and Sir Henry Lee.
- 12 The married name of Queen Anne Boleyn's paternal aunt, Anne Boleyn, who, with her husband, was in charge of the household of the Princesses Mary and Elizabeth.
- 13 This Anne was a Catholic recusant and helped shelter Catholic priests.
- 14 This Anne was the younger sister of Edward IV's consort and was married to William Bouchier, Viscount Bouchier, and George Grey, 2nd Earl of Kent.
