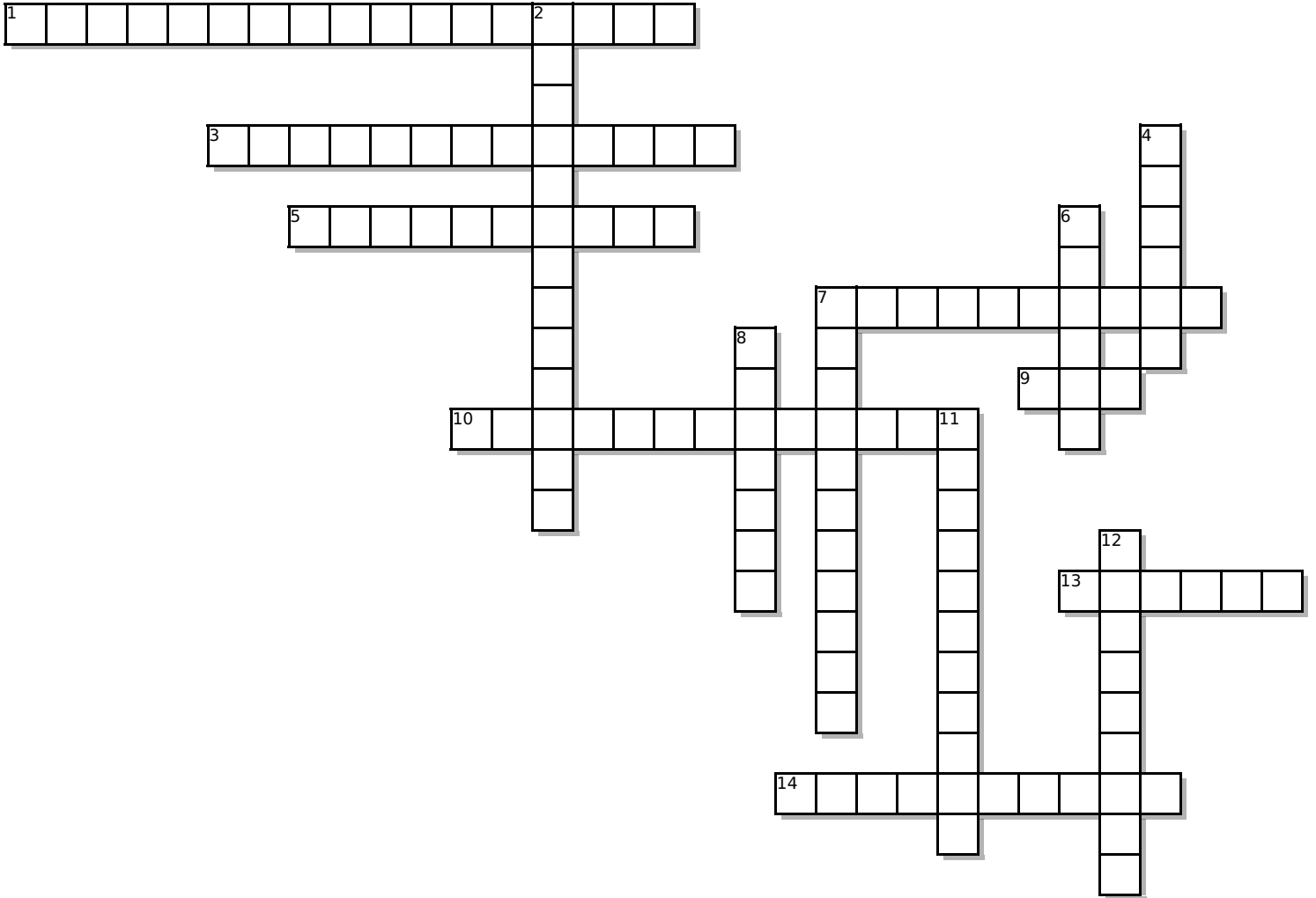


Rebellions in the reign of Edward VI



ACROSS

- 1 This battle ended the Prayer Book Rebellion on 17th August 1549.
- 3 Robert Kett was hanged here after the defeat of his rebellion.
- 5 This battle brought Kett's Rebellion to an end on 27th August 1549.
- 7 This Earl of Warwick was successful in putting down Kett's Rebellion.
- 9 The rebels of the Prayer Book Rebellion called for the rebuilding of abbeys, the restoration of the Articles, the restoration of prayers for souls in purgatory, the policy of only the bread being given to the laity and the use of Latin for the mass.
- 10 This man was the main composer of the Book of Common Prayer, the official liturgy of Edward VI's Protestant Church.
- 13 Kett's Rebellion of Summer 1549 was led by Norfolk farmer, Kett.

- 2 This man was the leader of Edward VI's government during both 1549 rebellions.
- 4 The rebels of the Prayer Book Rebellion laid siege to this city.
- 6 On 6th June 1549, rebels of the Prayer Book Rebellion assembled at this town and put forward their grievances at a town meeting.
- 7 This Earl of Bedford was the leader of the Crown forces against the rebels of the Prayer Book Rebellion.
- 8 On 22nd July 1549, the rebels of Kett's Rebellion attacked and took this city.
- 11 The rebels of Kett's Rebellion heard cases from guilty landowners under the Oak of
