
The Reign of King Henry VII



ACROSS

- 3 Henry VII died at this palace on 21st April 1509.
- 9 Henry Tudor (Henry VII) defeated Richard III at this battle in August 1485.
- 10 This treaty arranged the marriage of Henry's eldest son, Arthur, and Catherine of Aragon.
- 12 Edmund Dudley and this man became unpopular because they carried out Henry VII's taxation and financial policies.
- 13 This Earl of Warwick was beheaded for treason in 1499 after allegedly planning to escape from the Tower of London.
- 14 This explorer was granted letters patent by Henry for an exploratory voyage in 1496.

DOWN

- 1 This treaty arranged the marriage of Henry's eldest daughter, Margaret, and James IV of Scotland.
- 2 This cardinal served under Henry as Lord Chancellor and Archbishop of Canterbury.
- 4 Henry made this pretender a servant in his kitchens.
- 5 This battle in 1487 is considered the last battle of the Wars of the Roses.
- 6 Henry VII repealed this statute that had ruled the marriage of Edward IV and Elizabeth Woodville invalid and their children illegitimate.
- 7 Henry married Elizabeth of York here in 1486.
- 8 The bodyguard of the British monarch created by Henry VII and still in existence today.
- 11 This pretender was hanged in 1499.
